Dr. Gage has been rated in the top 2% of scholars in her field and is serving a sixyear term on the United Nations High-Level Advisory Board on Economic and Social Affairs.

She also serves as member of the Scientific Advisory Council of Institut National d'Études Démographiques (French Institute for Demographic Studies), Paris (2018-2027), and previously served as President of the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population (2014-2017) and member of the Board of Directors of the African Population and Health Research Center in Nairobi (2000-2006).
