The Spring 2024 sessions of the [Dean's Leaders & Lagniappe Lecture Series](#) have been set at [Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine](#).

In January, [Dean Daniele Fallin](#) from the Emory University Rollins School of Public Health and [Dean Perry Halkitis](#) from Rutgers University School of Public Health will appear together in a presentation and fireside chat with [Dean Thomas A. LaVeist](#) and audience.
