

# 2019 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report

The 2019 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 in the Environmental Health Sciences Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

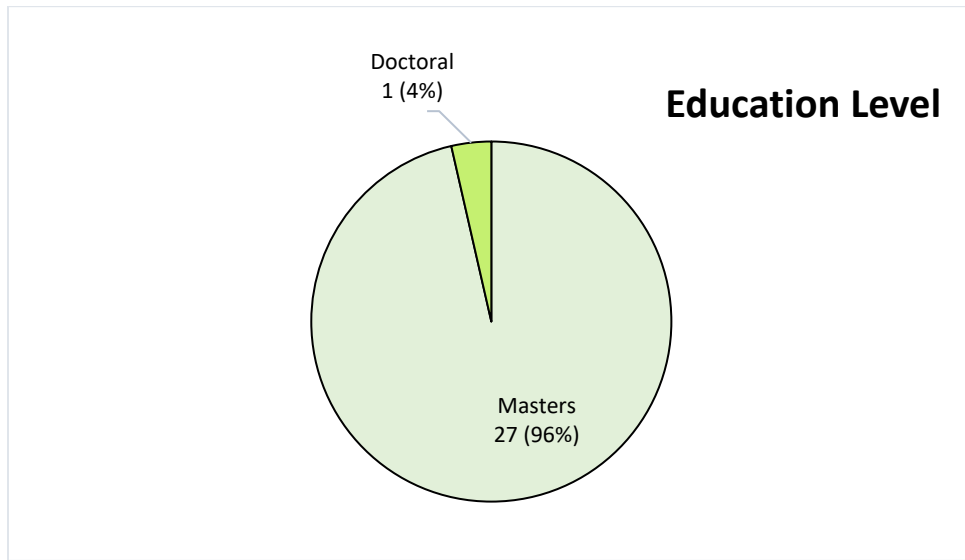
The SPHTM First Destination Survey was delivered to students with primary degrees in the Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. Surveys were sent beginning one month prior to each graduation term. Data was collected for one-year post-graduation. Aggregate data below represents members of the August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 graduating classes, and all data is self-reported.

**Data was not collected for students enrolled in the following Tulane joint degrees programs (MD/MPH, MD/MPH&TM, MD/MSPH, MD/PhD, MBA/MHA, JD/MHA).**

# 2019 Environmental Health Sciences Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 28 Environmental Health Sciences students in the survey, 27 (96%) graduated with Master Degrees and 1 (4%) graduated with a Doctoral Degree.



## Breakdown by Degree

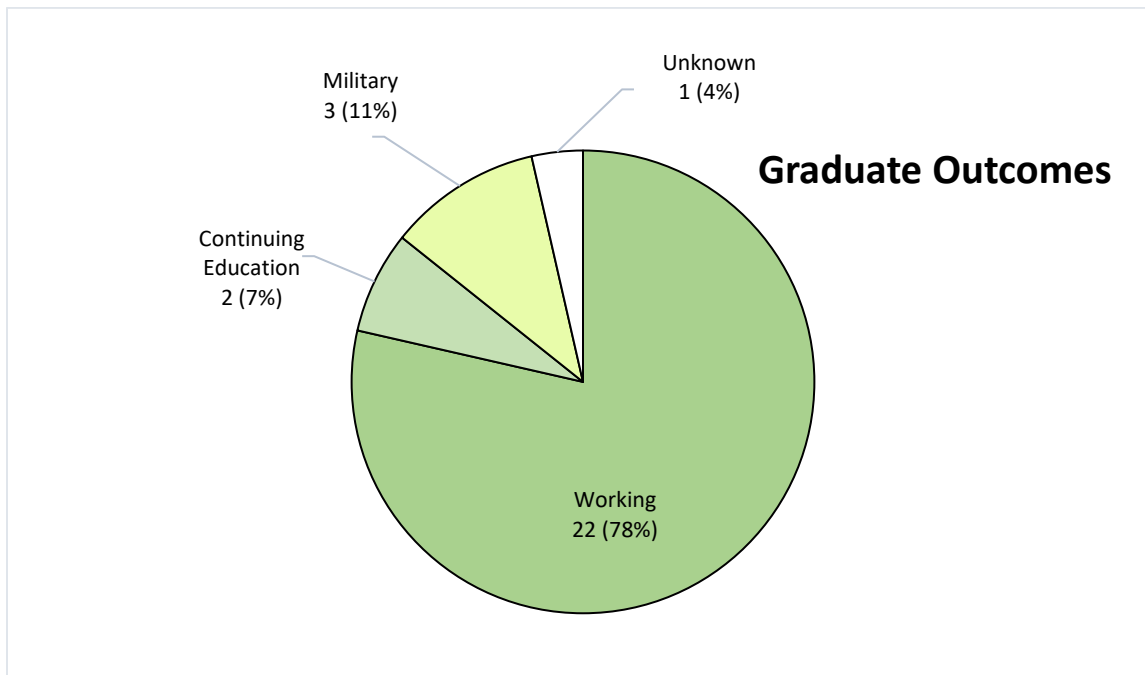
In the 2019 cycle, 20 students received a Master of Public Health (Concentrations in Disaster Management, Occupational and Environmental Health, Occupational Health and Safety Management), 7 students received a Master of Science in Public Health (Concentrations in Industrial Hygiene and Environmental Health Sciences), and 1 received a Doctor of Philosophy in Environmental Health Sciences.

## Environmental Health Sciences Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 28 Environmental Health Sciences student recipients, 27 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 96% response rate.

Of the 27 students who responded, **100% are working, volunteering, on military assignment, or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

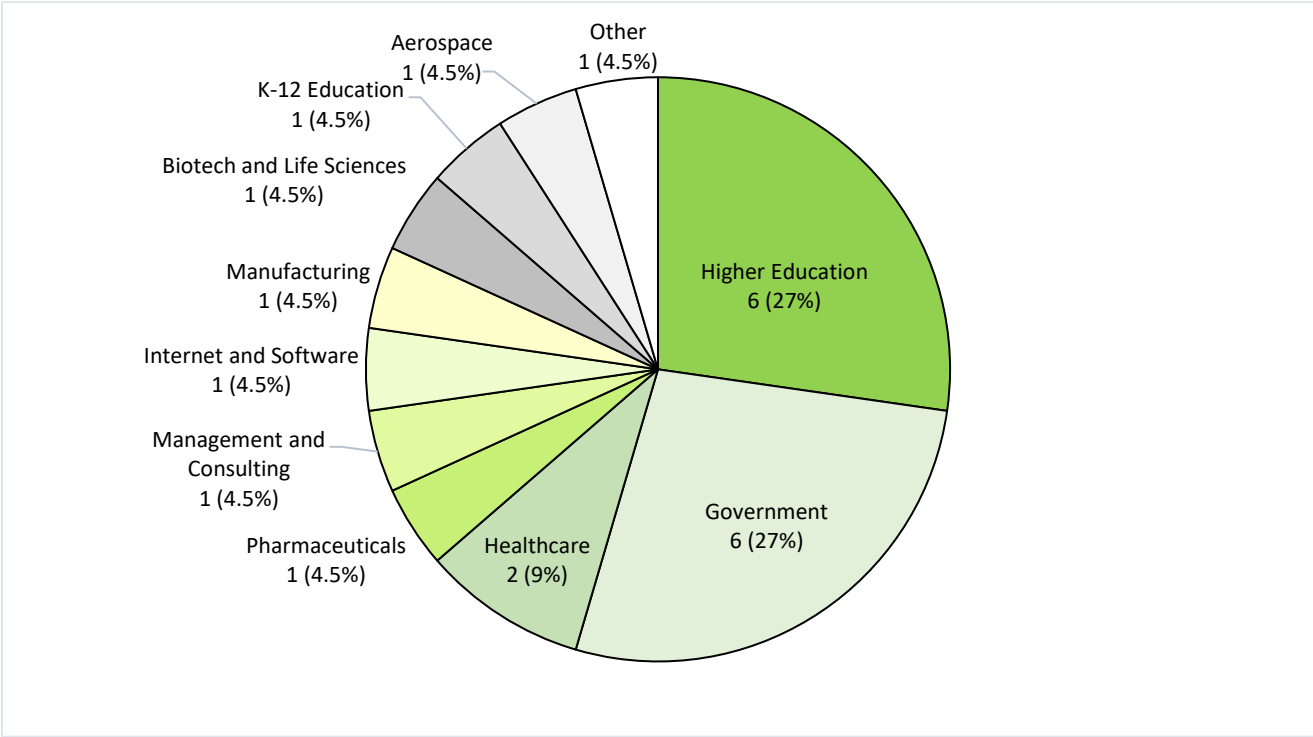

# Employment by Industry

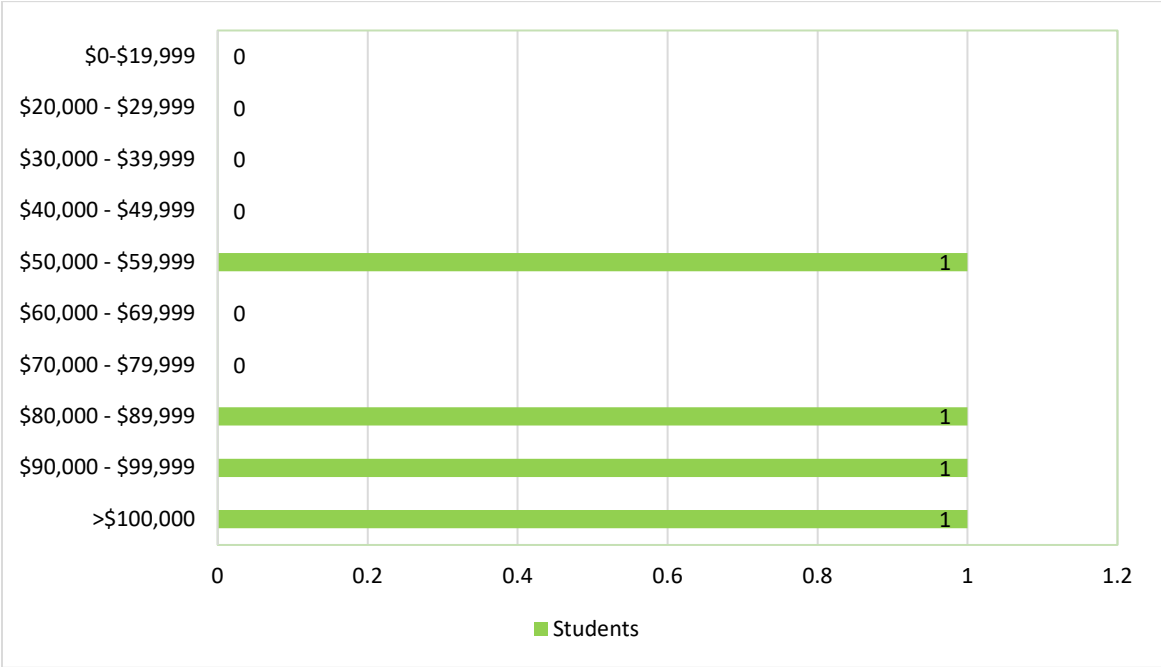

# Environmental Health Sciences Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by Environmental Health Sciences graduates securing employment is **\$85,000 - \$94,999**.
