

2019 Health Policy and Management Career Outcomes Report

The 2019 Health Policy and Management Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 in the Health Policy and Management Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

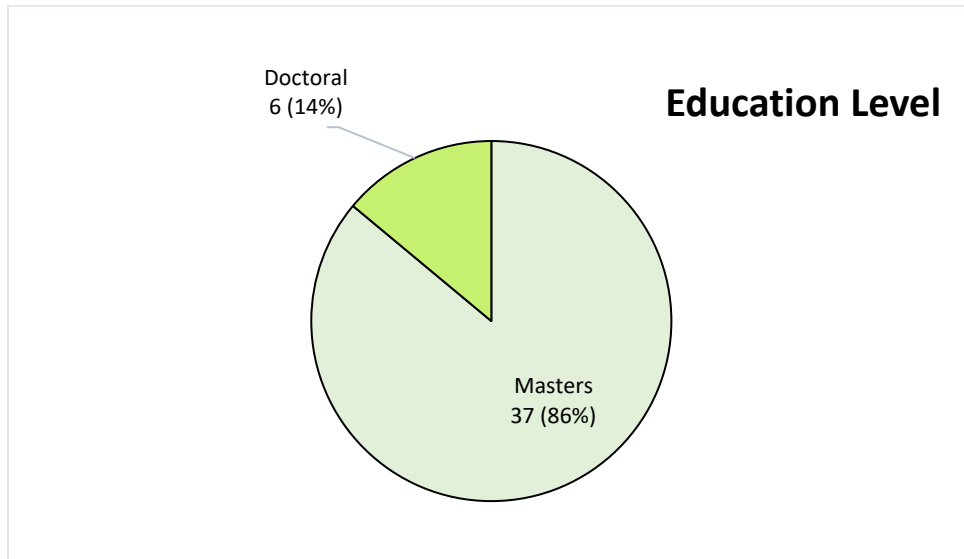
The SPHTM First Destination Survey was delivered to students with primary degrees in the Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. Surveys were sent beginning one month prior to each graduation term. Data was collected for one-year post-graduation. Aggregate data below represents members of the August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 graduating classes, and all data is self-reported.

Data was not collected for students enrolled in the following Tulane joint degrees programs (MD/MPH, MD/MPH&TM, MD/MSPH, MD/PhD, MBA/MHA, JD/MHA).

Education Level

Of the 43 Health Policy and Management students in the survey, 37 (86%) graduated with Master Degrees and 6 (14%) graduated with Doctoral Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

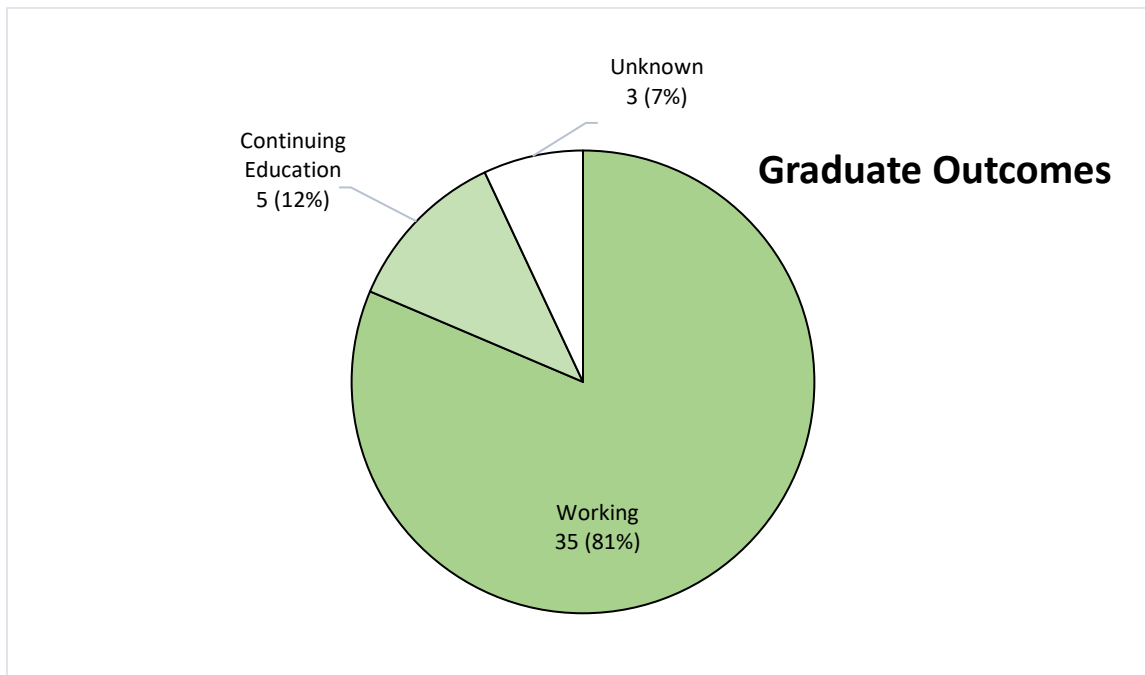
In the 2019 cycle, 14 students received a Master of Public Health (Concentrations in Health Policy, Health Systems Management), 23 students received a Master of Health Administration, 3 students received a Doctor of Philosophy in Global Health Systems Management and Policy, 2 received a Doctor of Science in Global Health Systems Management and Policy, and 1 received a Doctor of Science in Health Systems Management.

Health Policy and Management Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 43 Health Policy and Management student recipients, 40 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 93% response rate.

Of the 40 students who responded, **100% are working** (including volunteering and military assignments) **or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

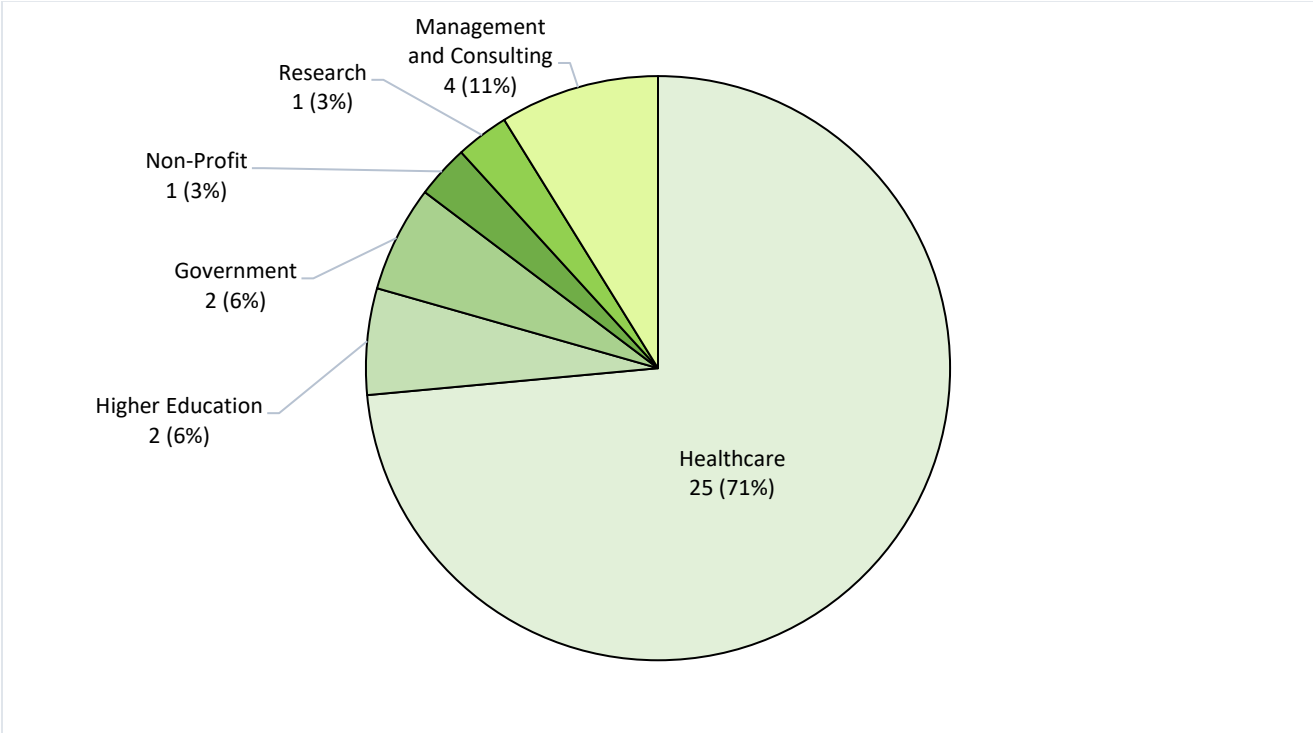

Employment by Industry

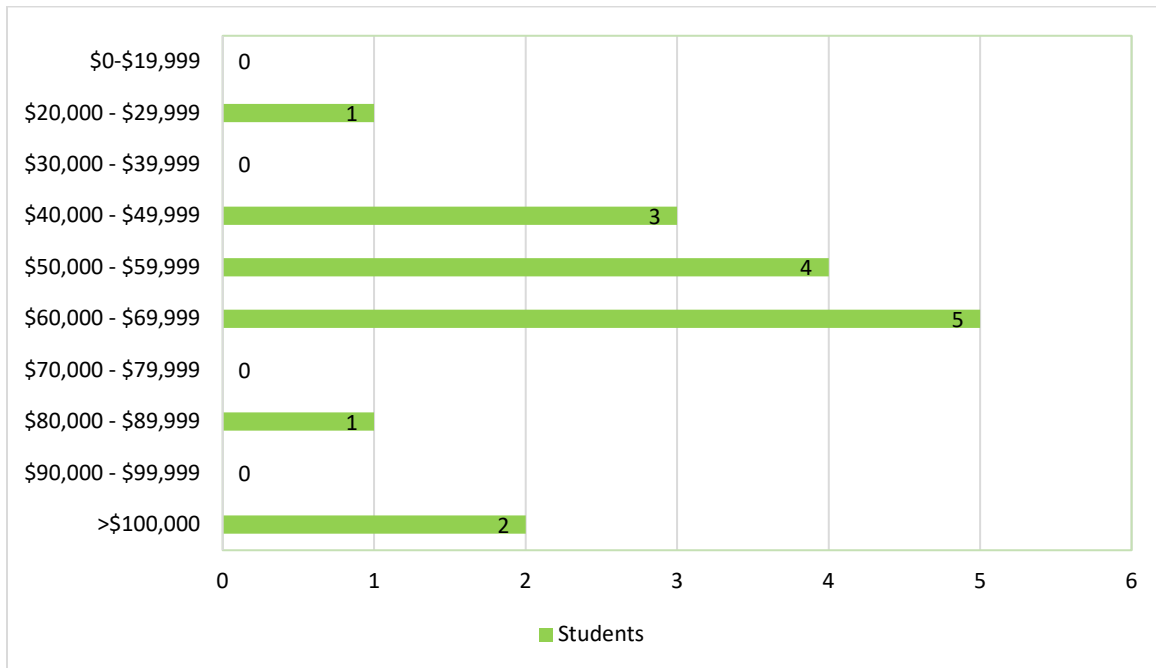
Of the 35 students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Industries included Healthcare, Higher Education, Government, Non-Profit, Research, and Management and Consulting.



Health Policy and Management Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by graduates securing employment is **\$55,000 - \$64,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 35 students that reported “Working”, 16 students (46%) chose to report their income.
