

2019 Tropical Medicine Career Outcomes Report

The 2019 Tropical Medicine Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 in the Tropical Medicine Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

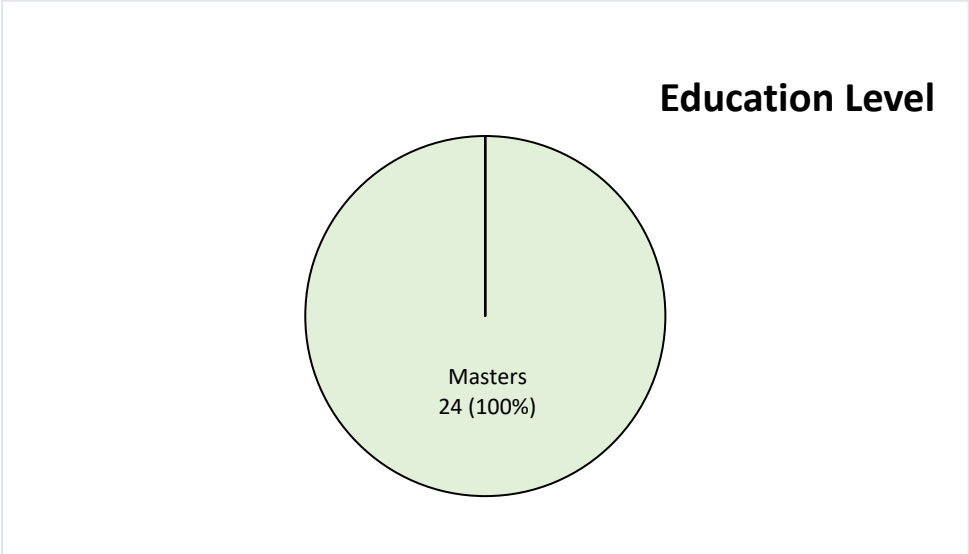
The SPHTM First Destination Survey was delivered to students with primary degrees in the Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. Surveys were sent beginning one month prior to each graduation term. Data was collected for one-year post-graduation. Aggregate data below represents members of the August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 graduating classes, and all data is self-reported.

Data was not collected for students enrolled in the following Tulane joint degrees programs (MD/MPH, MD/MPH&TM, MD/MSPH, MD/PhD, MBA/MHA, JD/MHA).

Education Level

Of the 24 Tropical Medicine students in the survey, all 24 students (100%) graduated with Master Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

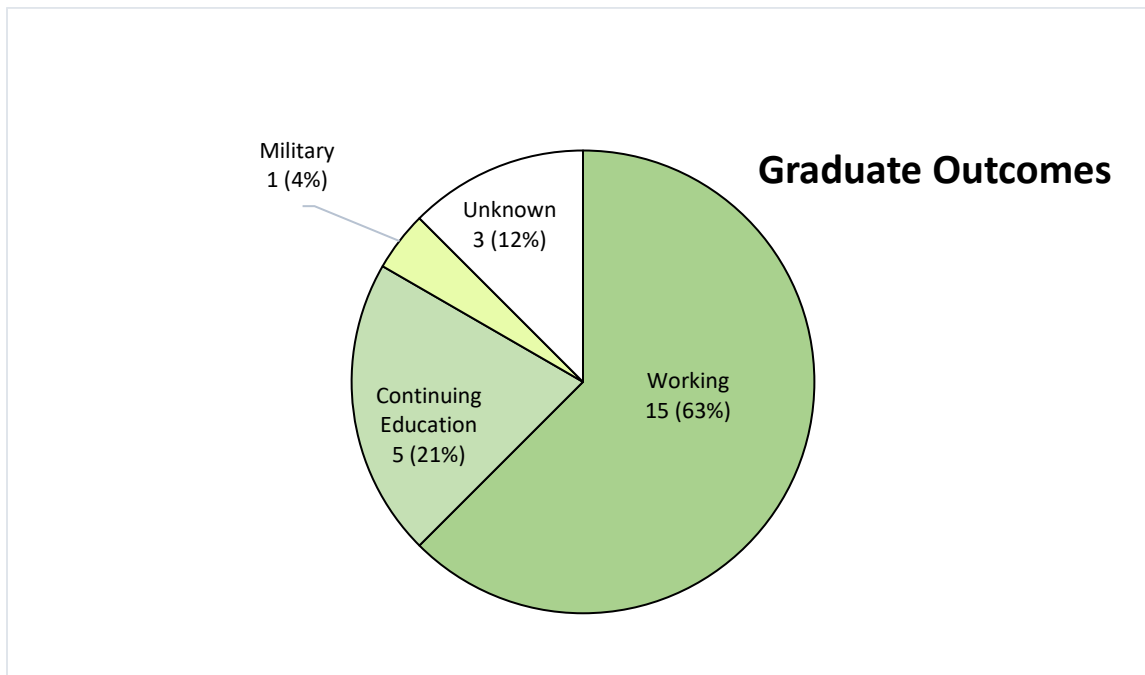
In the 2019 cycle, 9 students received a Master of Science in Public Health in Tropical Medicine and 15 students received a Master of Public Health and Tropical Medicine.

Tropical Medicine Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 24 Tropical Medicine student recipients, 21 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 88% response rate.

Of the 21 students who responded, **100% are working, volunteering, on military assignment, or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

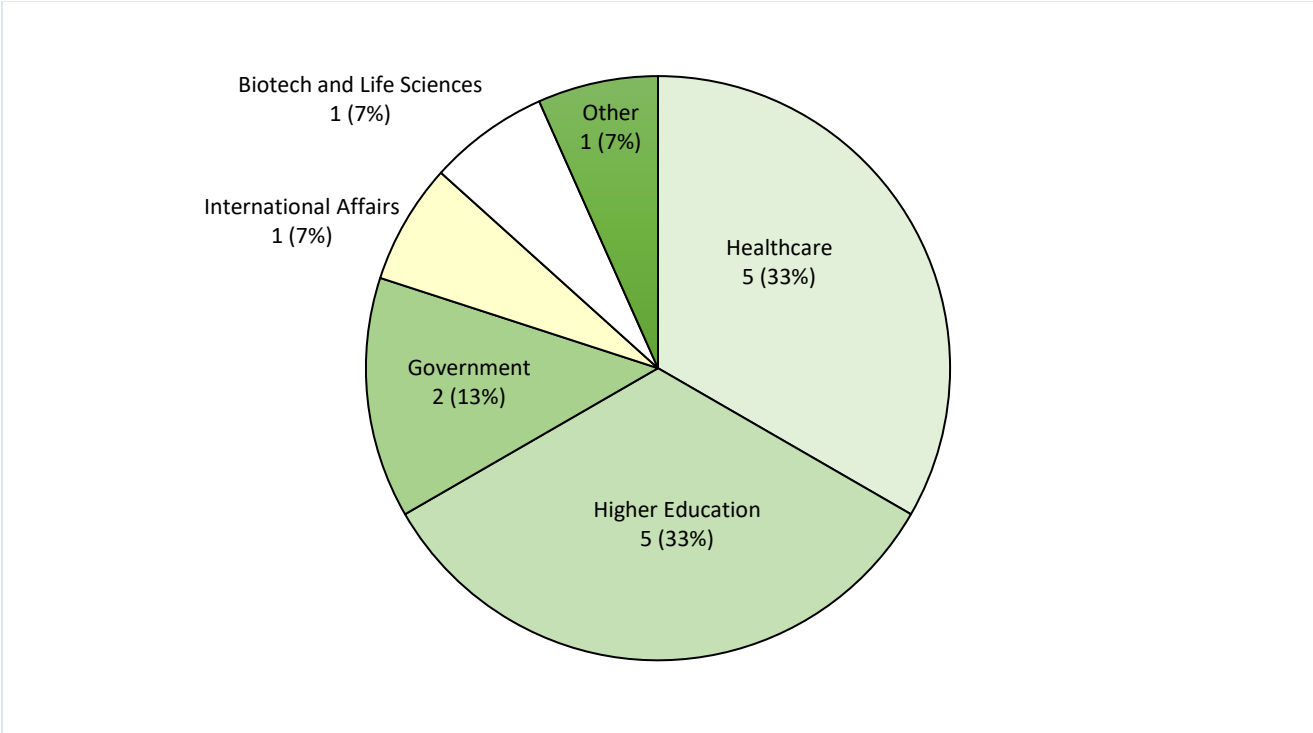

Employment by Industry

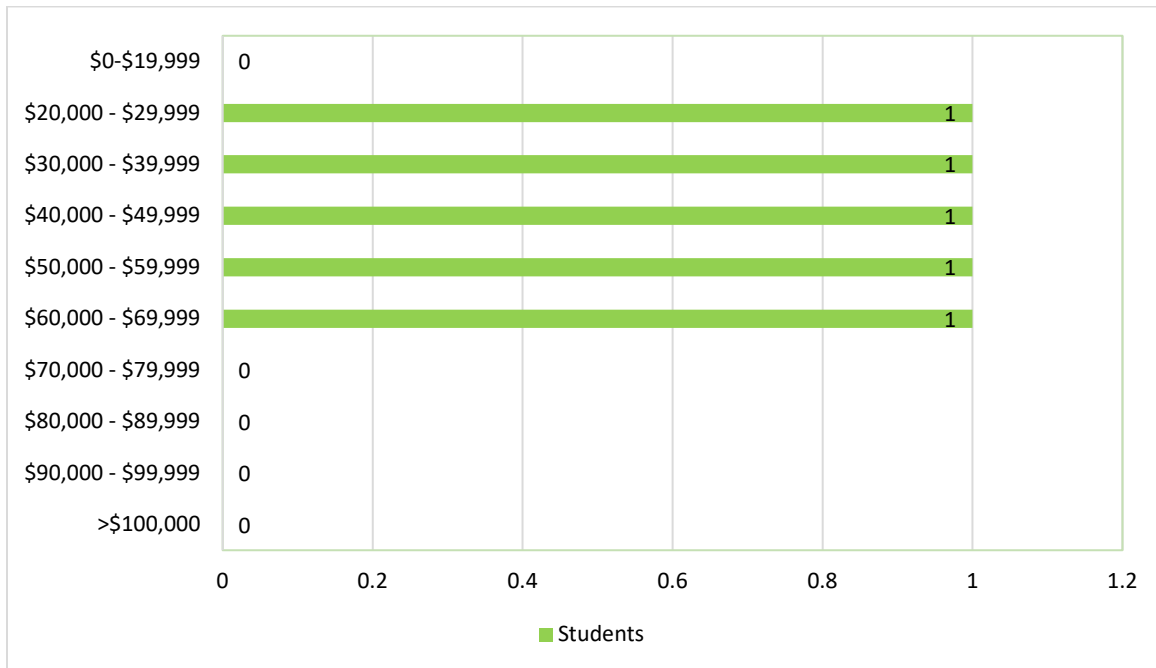
Of the 15 Tropical Medicine students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Industries included Healthcare, Higher Education, Government, International Affairs, Biotech and Life Sciences, and Other Industries.



Tropical Medicine Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by Tropical Medicine graduates securing employment is **\$40,000 - \$49,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 15 students that reported “Working”, 5 students (33%) chose to report their income.
