

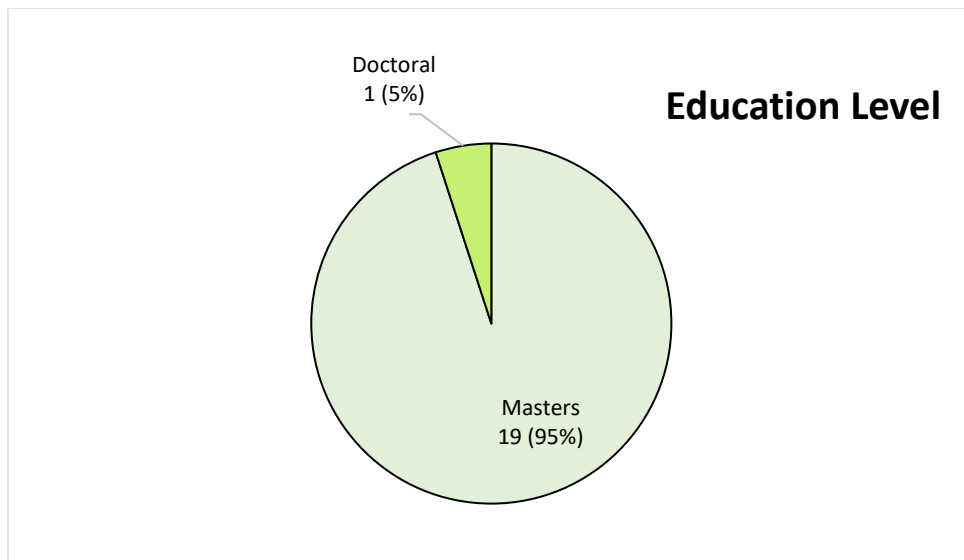
2020 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report

The 2020 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2019, December 2019, and May 2020 in the Environmental Health Sciences Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2020 Environmental Health Sciences Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 20 student recipients in the Environmental Health Sciences Department, 19 (95%) graduated with Master Degrees and 1 (5%) graduated with a Doctoral Degree.



Breakdown by Degree

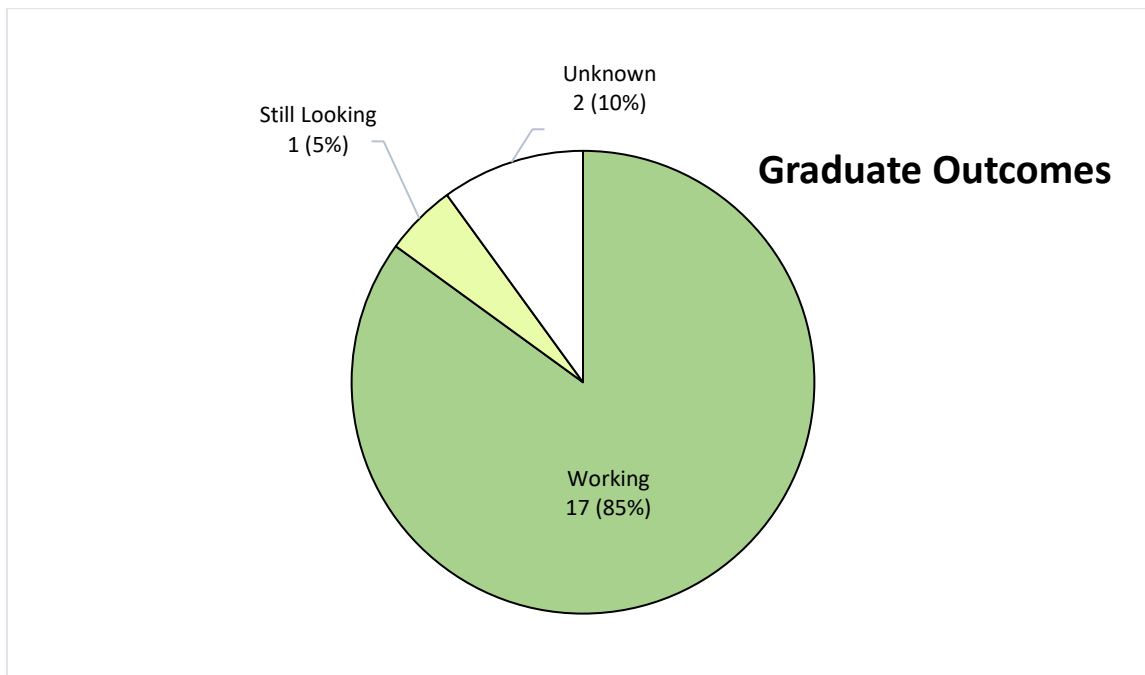
In the 2020 cycle, 14 students received a Master of Public Health (Concentrations in Disaster Management, Occupational Health and Safety Management), 5 students received a Master of Science in Public Health (Concentrations in Industrial Hygiene and Environmental Health Sciences), and 1 received a Doctor of Philosophy in Environmental Health Sciences.

Environmental Health Sciences Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 20 Environmental Health Sciences student recipients, 18 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 90% response rate.

Of the 18 students who responded, **94% are working within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

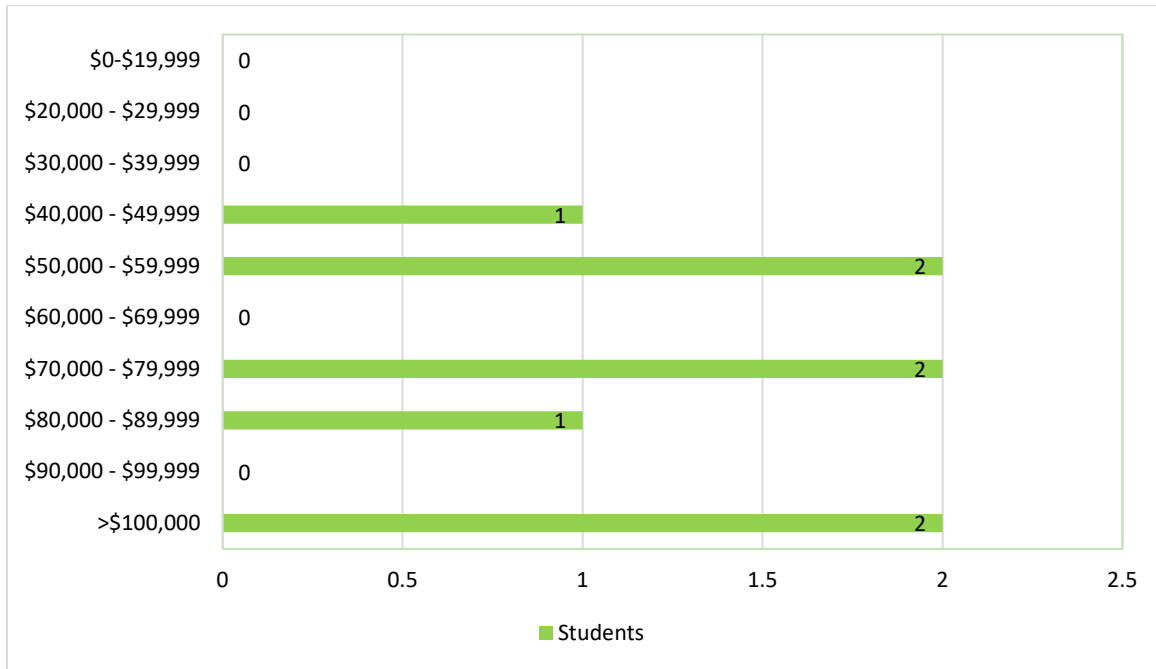
