

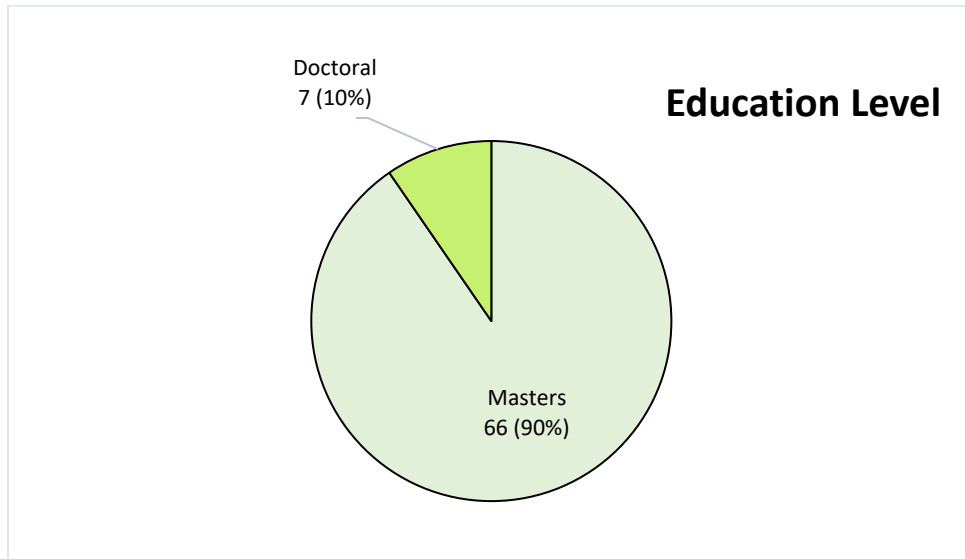
## **2020 GCHB Career Outcomes Report**

The 2020 GCHB Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2019, December 2019, and May 2020 in the Global Community Health and Behavioral Sciences Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

# 2020 GCHB Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 73 student recipients in the GCHB Department, 66 (90%) graduated with Master Degrees and 7 (10%) graduated with a Doctoral Degree.



## Breakdown by Degree

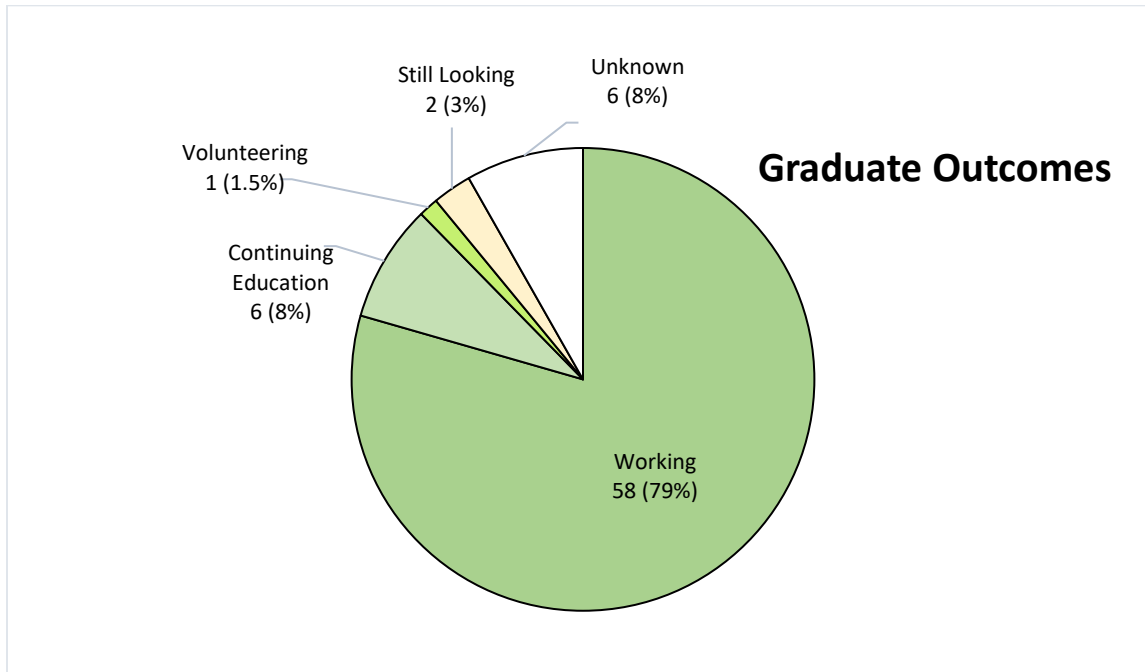
In the 2020 cycle, 66 students received Master of Public Health Degrees (Concentrations in Nutrition, Health Education and Communication, International Health and Development, Maternal and Child Health, and Community Health Sciences). 6 students received a Doctor of Philosophy and 1 student received a Doctor of Public Health.

## GCHB Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 73 GCHB student recipients, 67 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 92% response rate.

Of the 67 students who responded, **97% are working, volunteering, or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

## Employment by Sector

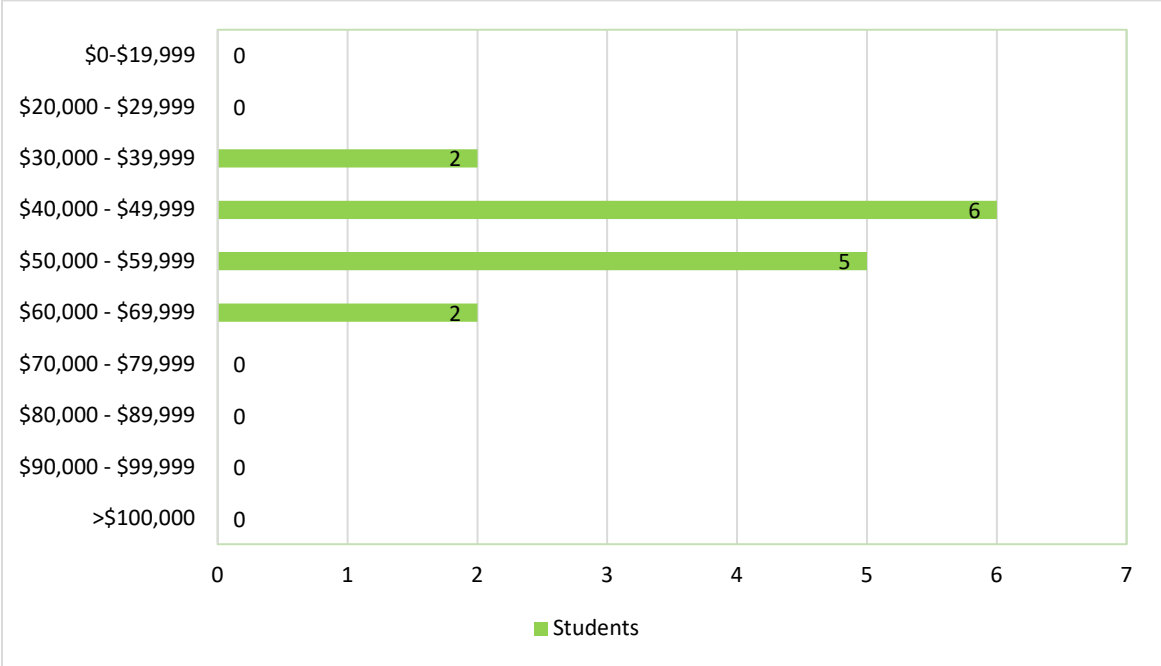

# GCHB Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by GCHB graduates securing employment is **\$40,000 - \$49,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 58 students that reported “Working”, 15 students (26%) chose to report their income.
