

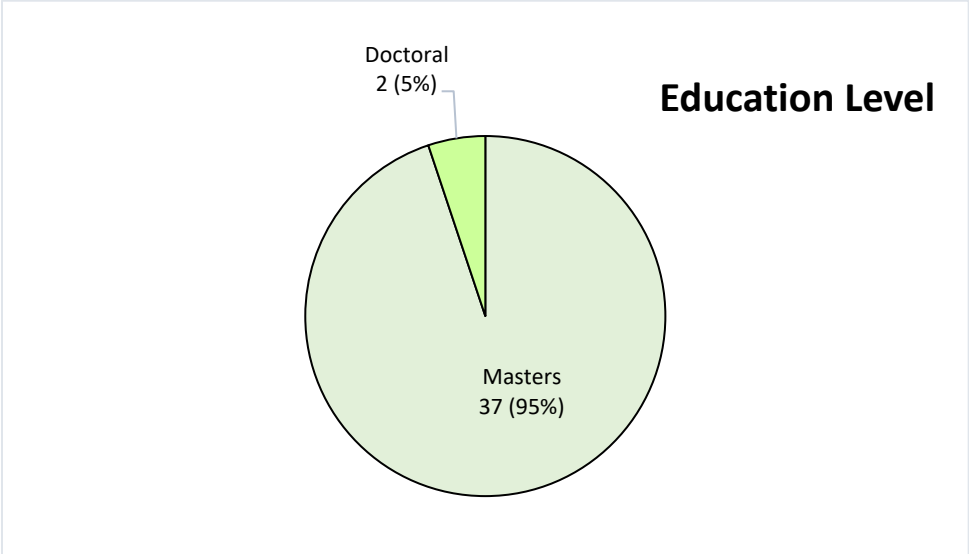
## 2020 Tropical Medicine Career Outcomes Report

The 2020 Tropical Medicine Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2019, December 2019, and May 2020 in the Tropical Medicine Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

# 2020 Tropical Medicine Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 39 student recipients in the Tropical Medicine Department, 37 students (95%) graduated with Master Degrees and 2 (5%) students graduated with Doctoral Degrees.



## Breakdown by Degree

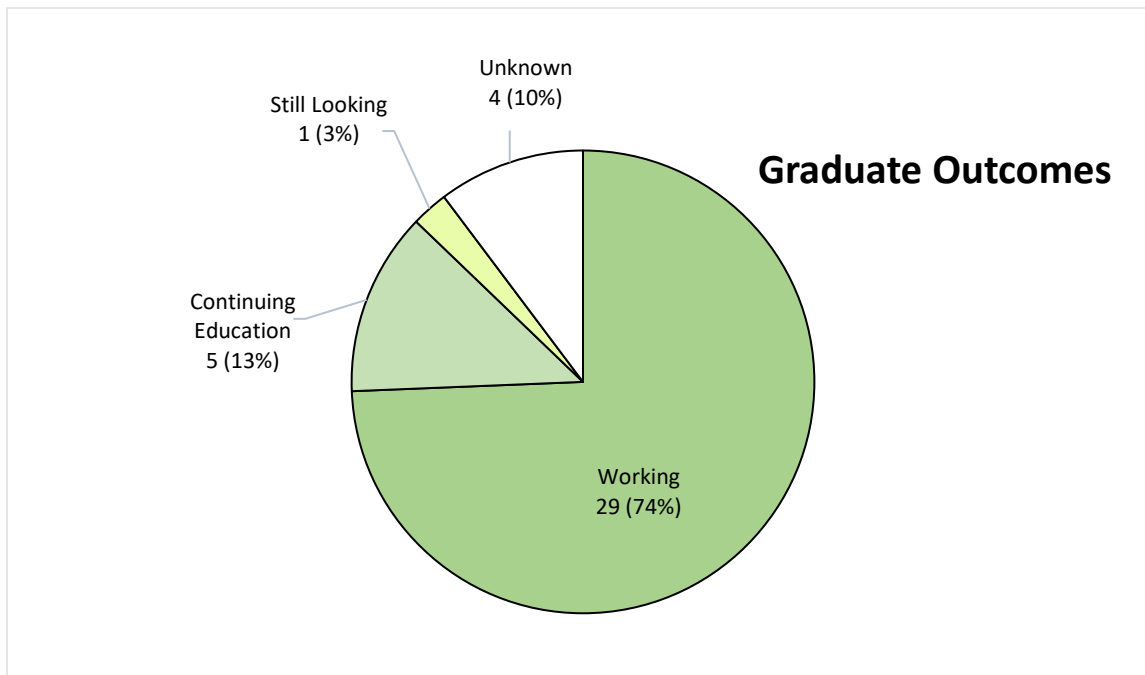
In the 2020 cycle, 4 students received a Master of Science in Public Health and Tropical Medicine, 2 students received a Master of Science in Tropical Medicine, 31 students received a Master of Public Health and Tropical Medicine, and 2 students received a Doctor of Philosophy.

## Tropical Medicine Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 39 Tropical Medicine student recipients, 35 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 90% response rate.

Of the 35 students who responded, **97% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

## Employment by Sector

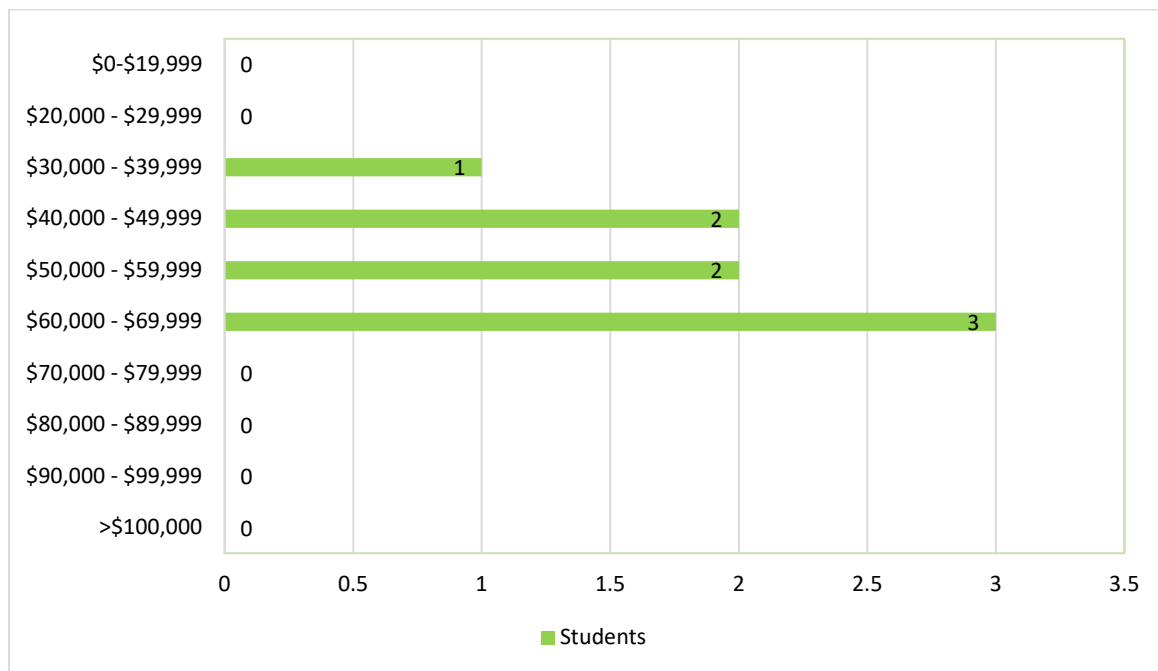
Of the 29 Tropical Medicine students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Sectors included Healthcare, Higher Education, Government, Research, Non-Profit, and Defense.

## Tropical Medicine Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by Tropical Medicine graduates securing employment is **\$50,000 - \$59,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 29 students that reported “Working”, 8 students (28%) chose to report their income.
