

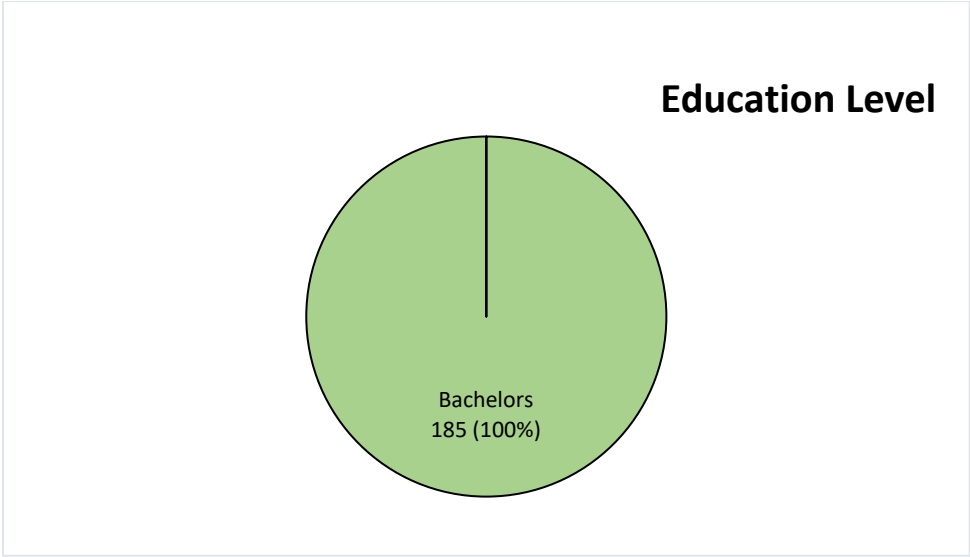
2021 BSPH Career Outcomes Report

The 2021 BSPH Career Outcomes Report includes data from students who received a Bachelor of Science in Public Health degree in the graduating classes of August 2020, December 2020, and May 2021. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2021 BSPH Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 185 student recipients in the Bachelor of Science in Public Health Department, 185 (100%) graduated with Bachelor Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

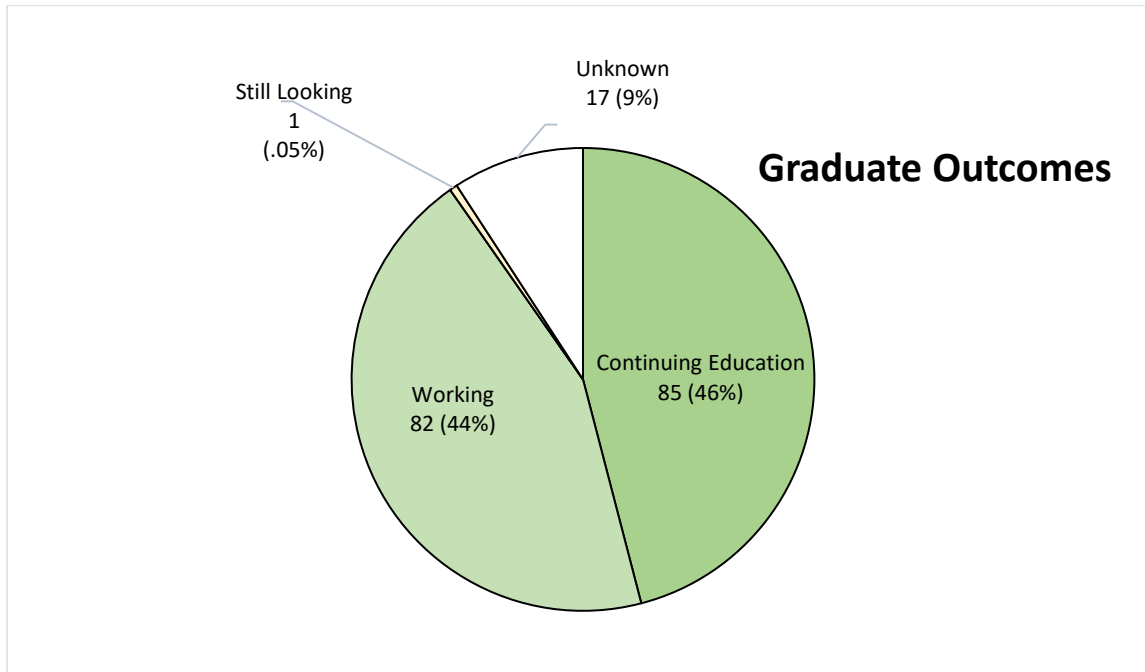
In the 2021 cycle, 185 students received a Bachelor of Science in Public Health degree.

BSPH Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 185 BSPH student recipients, 168 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 91% response rate.

Of the 168 students who responded, **99% are working, volunteering, or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

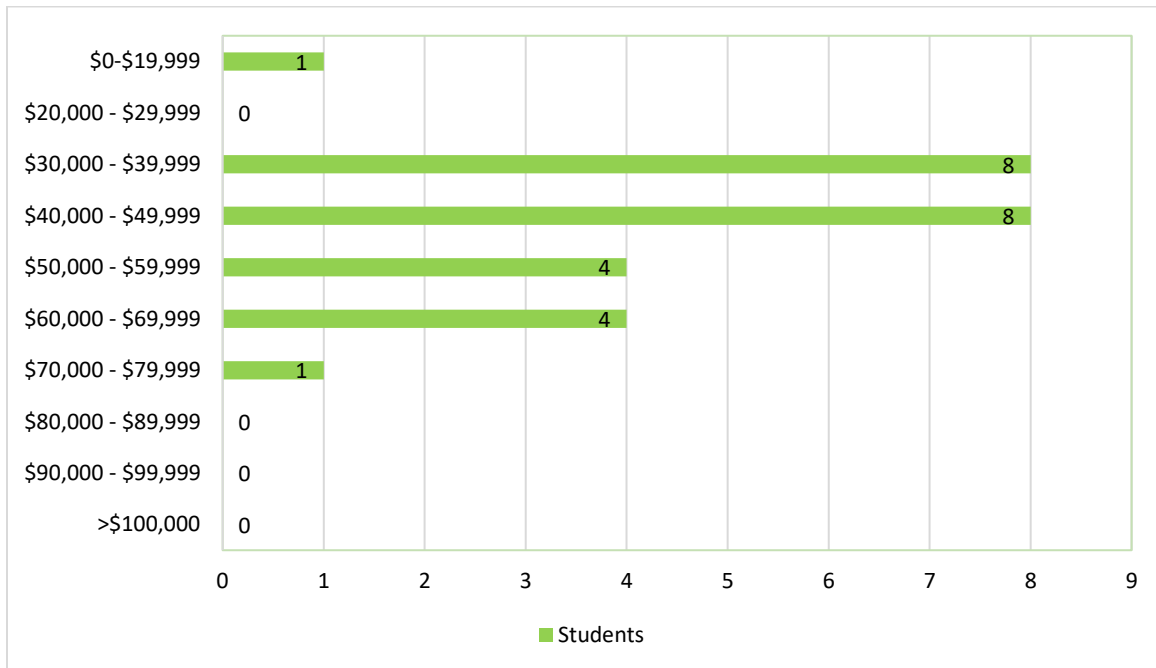
Of the 82 students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, the 10 Employment Sectors were Healthcare, Non-Profit, Higher Education, Management and Consulting, Government (Local, State, and Federal), Internet and Software, Research, Advertising/PR/Marketing, Biotech & Life Sciences, and Investment Banking.

BSPH Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by BSPH graduates securing employment is **\$40,000 - \$49,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 82 students that reported “Working”, 26 students (32%) chose to report their income.
