

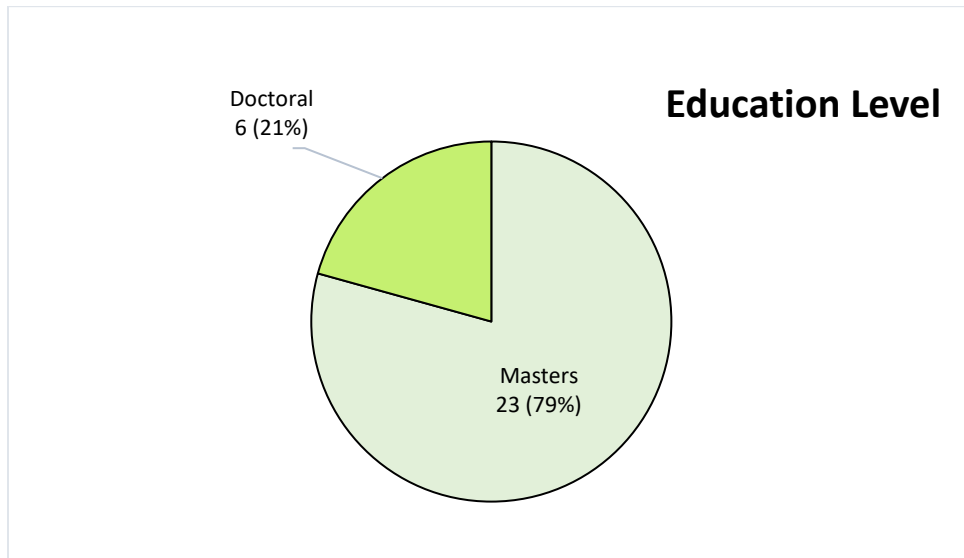
2021 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report

The 2021 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2020, December 2020, and May 2021 in the Environmental Health Sciences Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2021 Environmental Health Sciences Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 29 student recipients in the Environmental Health Sciences Department, 23 (79%) graduated with Master Degrees and 6 (21%) graduated with a Doctoral Degree.



Breakdown by Degree

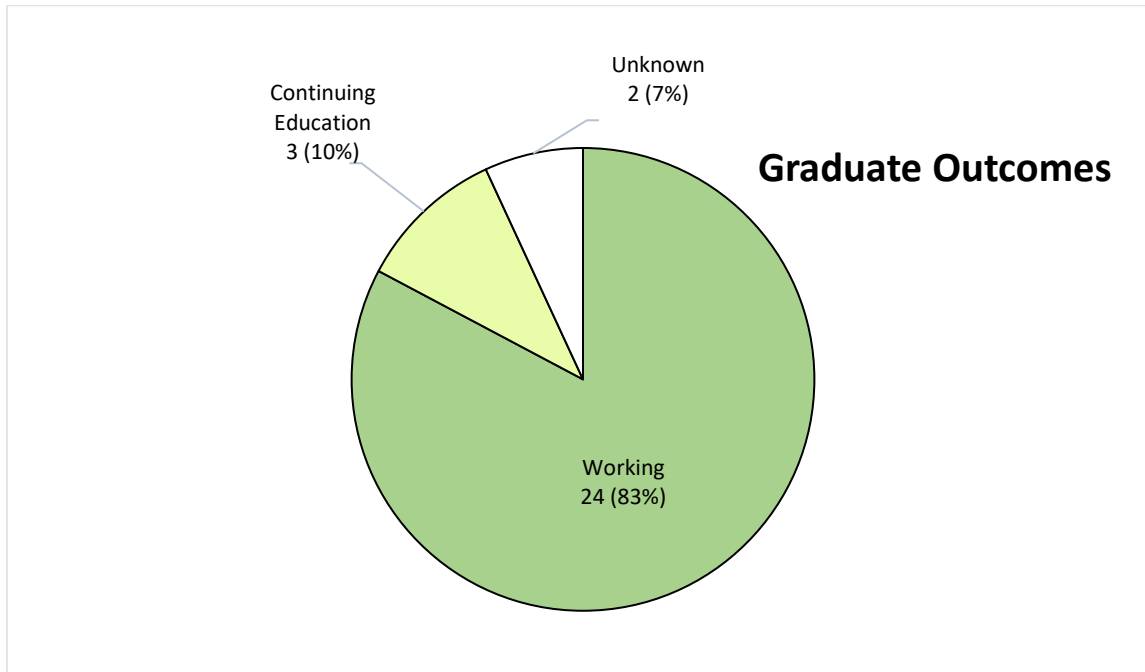
In the 2021 cycle, 22 students received a Master of Public Health (Concentrations in Disaster Management, Occupational Health and Environmental Health Sciences, Occupational Health and Safety Management), 1 student received a Master of Science in Public Health (Concentration in Industrial Hygiene), and 6 received a Doctor of Philosophy in Environmental Health Sciences.

Environmental Health Sciences Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 29 Environmental Health Sciences student recipients, 27 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 93% response rate.

Of the 27 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

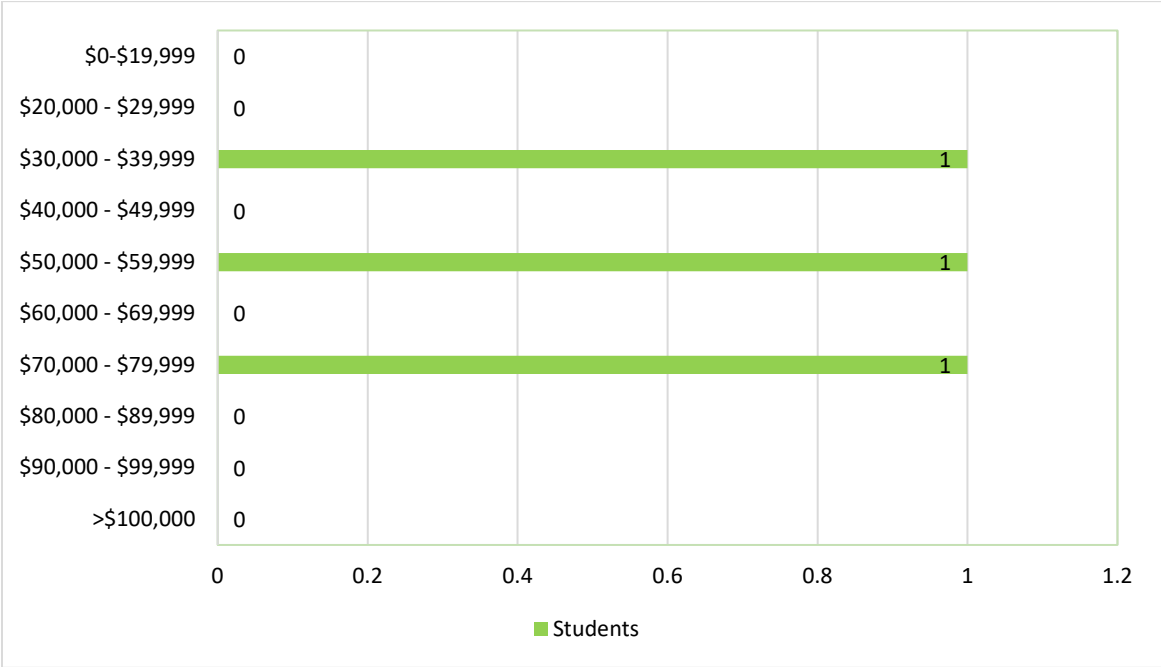
