

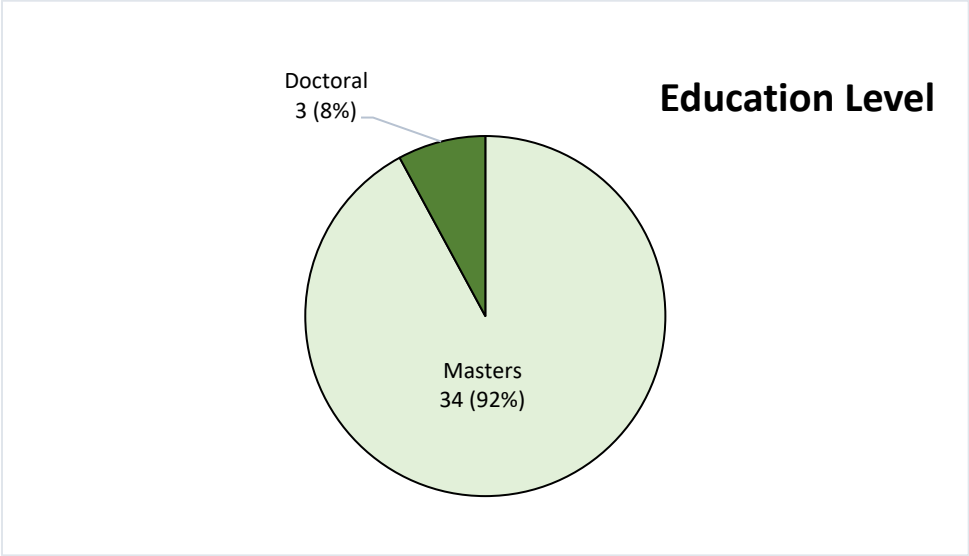
2021 Health Policy and Management Career Outcomes Report

The 2021 Health Policy and Management Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2020, December 2020, and May 2021 in the Health Policy and Management Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2021 Health Policy and Management Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 37 student recipients in the Health Policy and Management Department, 34 (92%) graduated with Master Degrees and 3 (8%) graduated with Doctoral Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

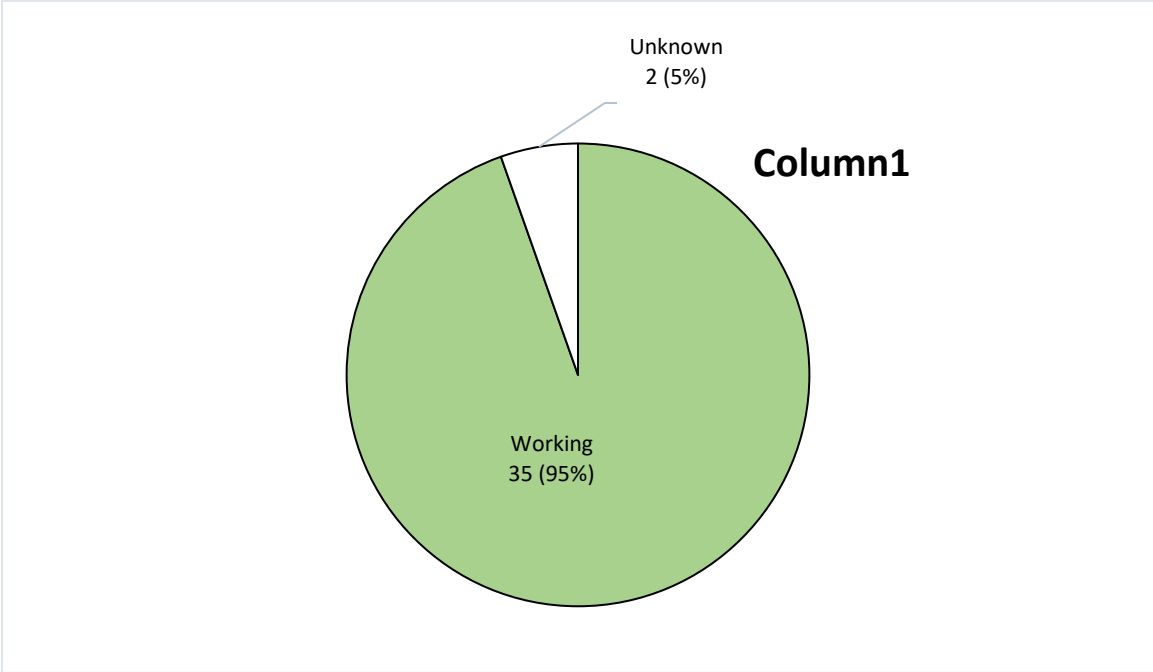
In the 2021 cycle, 16 students received a Master of Public Health (Concentrations in Health Policy, Health Systems Management), 18 students received a Master of Health Administration, 2 students received a PhD, and 1 student received a DSC.

Health Policy and Management Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 37 Health Policy and Management student recipients, 35 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 95% response rate.

Of the 35 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

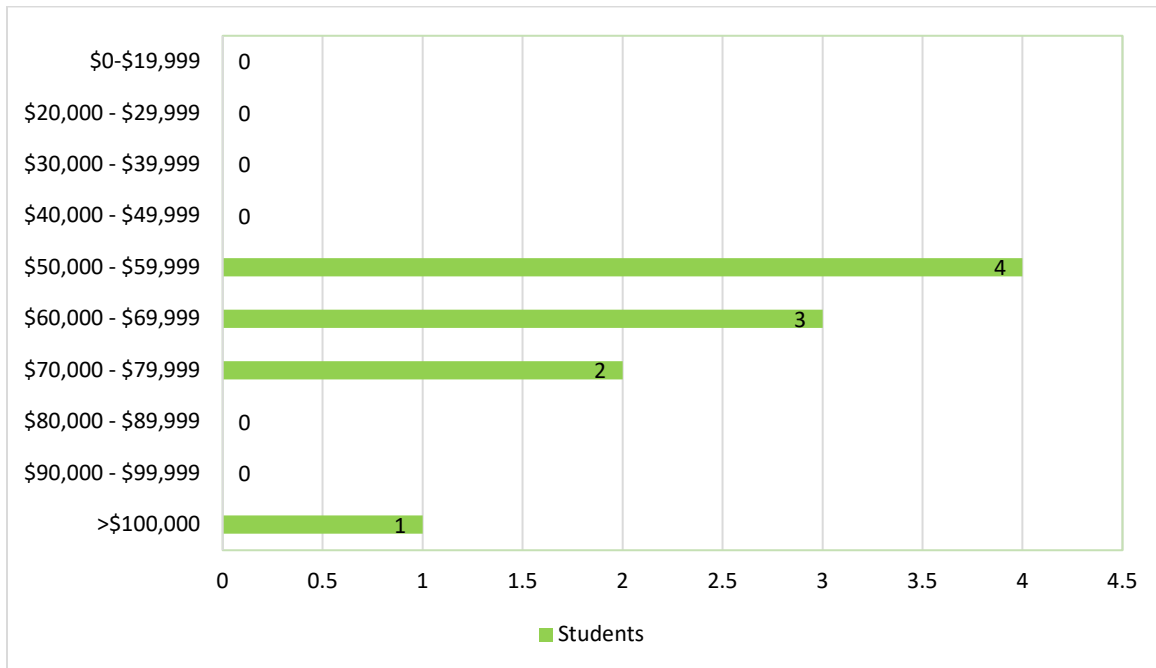
Of the 35 students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Sectors included Healthcare, Higher Education, Management and Consulting, Government – Consulting, Legal & Law Enforcement, Research, Government – Local, State & Federal.

Health Policy and Management Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by graduates securing employment is **\$60,000 - \$69,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 35 students that reported “Working”, 10 students (29%) chose to report their income.
