

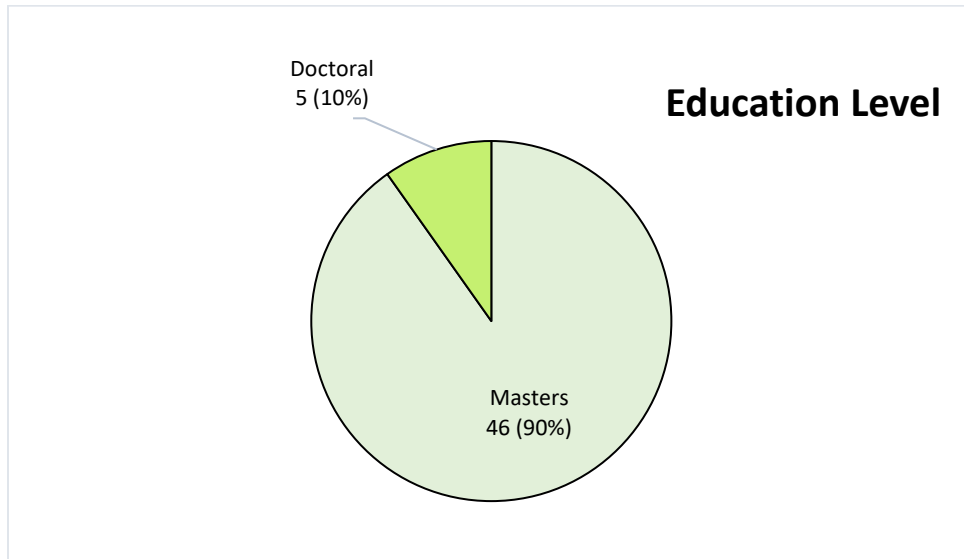
2021 SBPS Career Outcomes Report

The 2021 SBPS Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2020, December 2020, and May 2021 in the Social, Behavioral and Population Sciences Department, formerly the Global Community Health and Behavioral Science Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2021 SBPS Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 51 student recipients in the SBPS Department, 46 (90%) graduated with Master Degrees and 5 (10%) graduated with a Doctoral Degree.



Breakdown by Degree

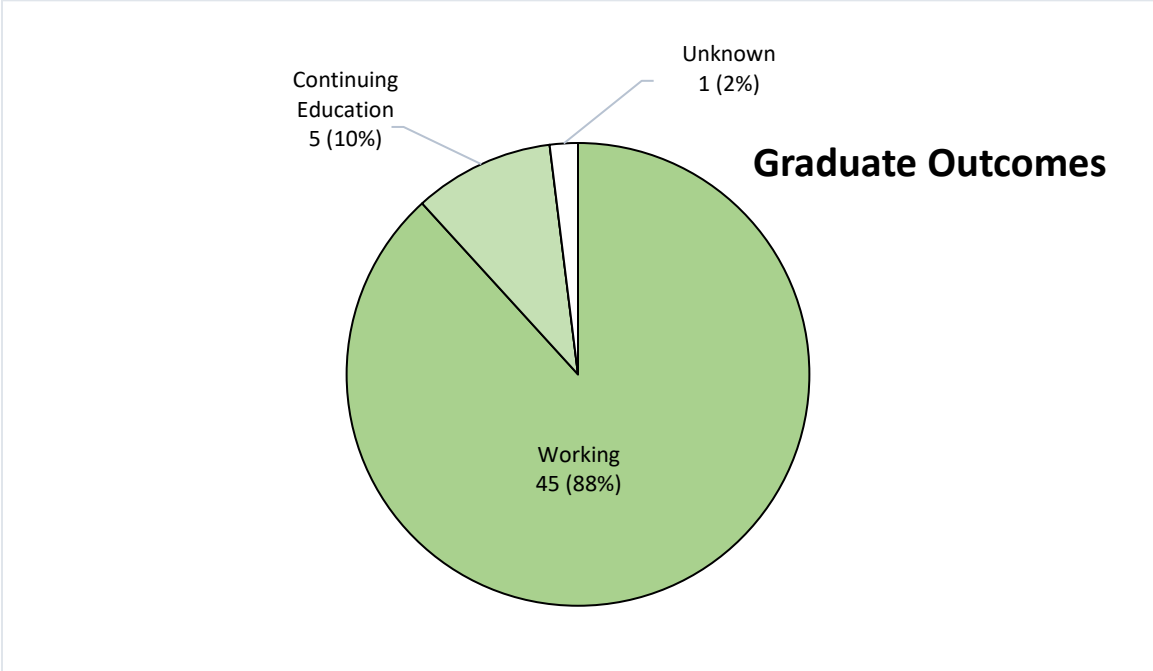
In the 2021 cycle, 46 students received Master of Public Health Degrees (Concentrations in Nutrition, Health Education and Communication, Maternal and Child Health, and Community Health Sciences). 3 students received a Doctor of Philosophy and 2 students received a Doctor of Public Health.

SBPS Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 51 SBPS student recipients, 50 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 98% response rate.

Of the 50 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

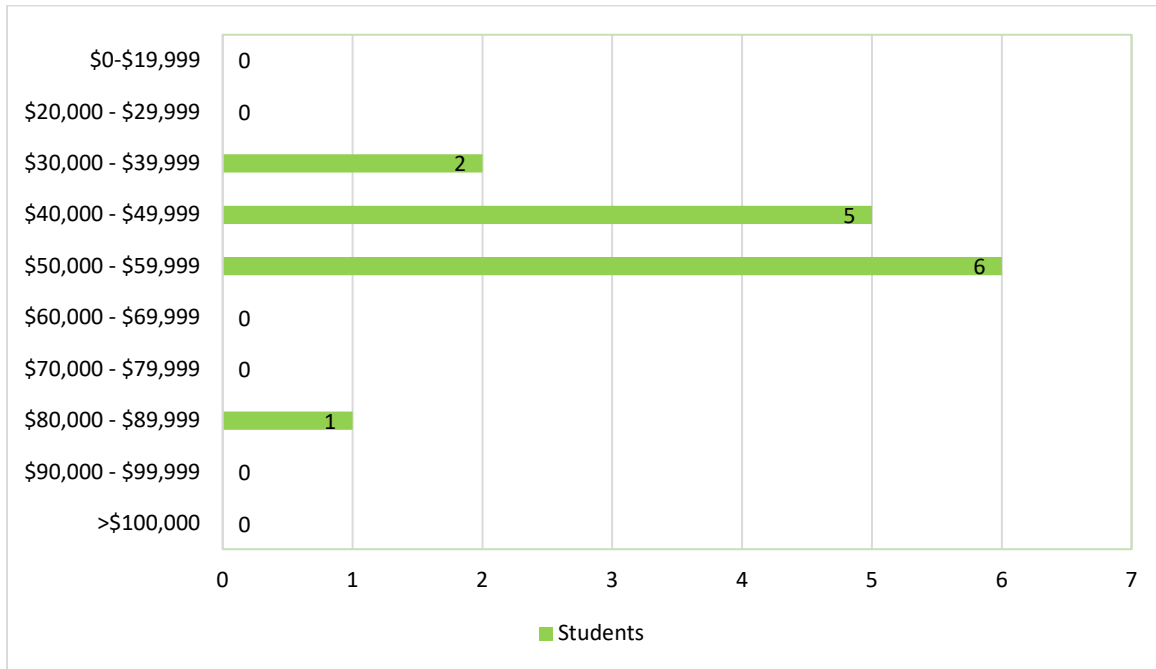

SBPS Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by SBPS graduates securing employment is **\$45,000 - \$54,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 45 students that reported “Working”, 14 students (31%) chose to report their income.
