

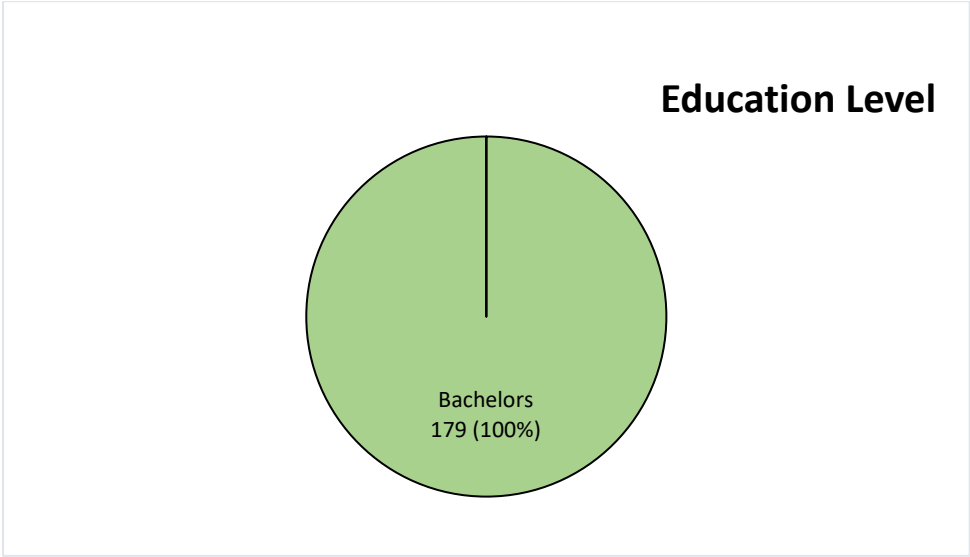
# 2022 BSPH Career Outcomes Report

The 2022 BSPH Career Outcomes Report includes data from students who received a Bachelor of Science in Public Health degree in the graduating classes of August 2021, December 2021, and May 2022. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

# 2022 BSPH Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 179 students recipients in the Bachelor of Science in Public Health Department, 179 (100%) graduated with Bachelor Degrees.



## Breakdown by Degree

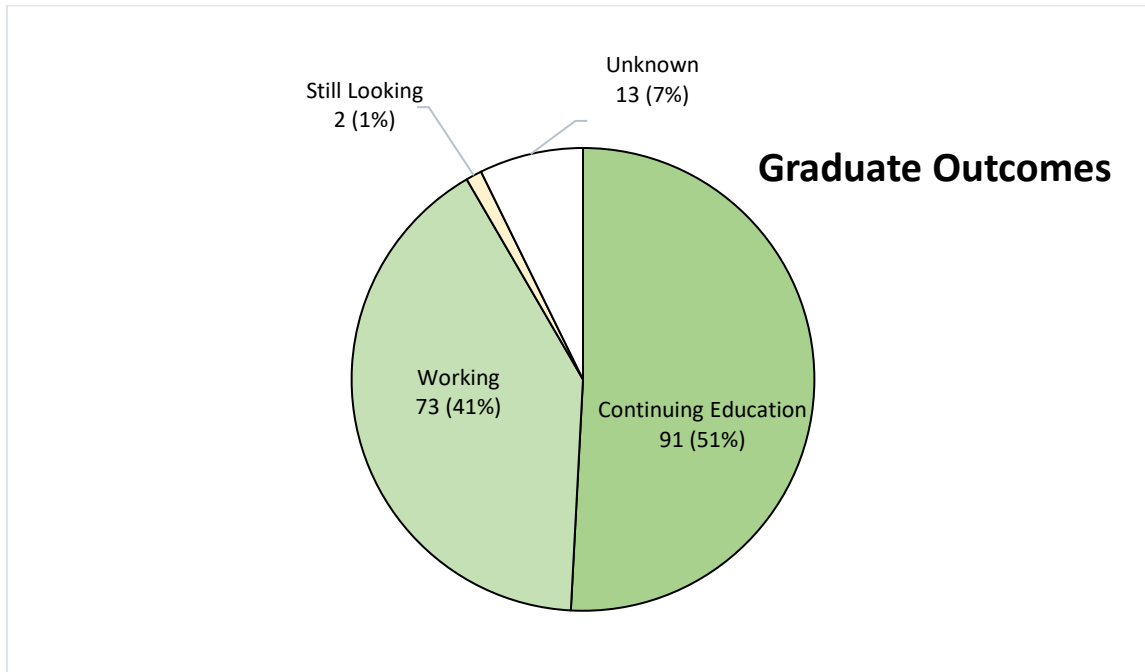
In the 2022 cycle, 179 students received a Bachelor of Science in Public Health degree.

## BSPH Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 179 BSPH student recipients, 166 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 93% response rate.

Of the 166 students who responded, **99% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

## Employment by Sector

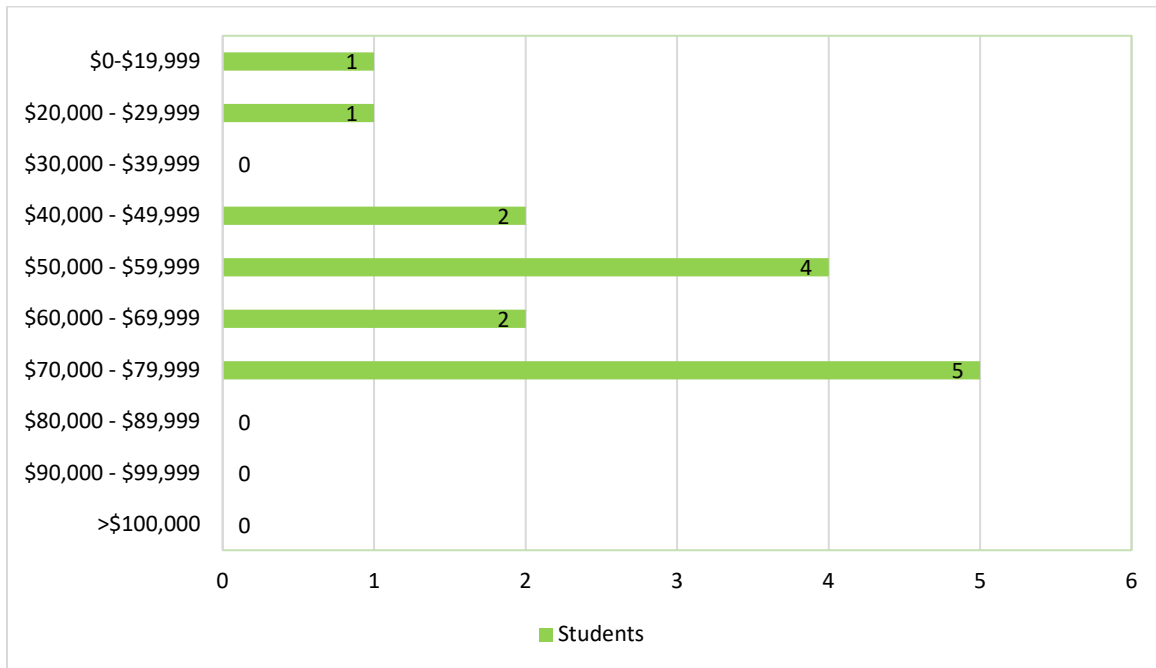

## BSPH Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by BSPH graduates securing employment is **\$50,000 - \$59,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 73 students that reported “Working”, 15 students (21%) chose to report their income.
