


2022 Environmental Health Sciences Career Outcomes Report

Breakdown by Degree



Environmental Health Sciences Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 25 Environmental Health Sciences student recipients, 19 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 76% response rate.

Of the 19 students who responded, **100%** are working or continuing education within **1** year of graduation.


Employment by Sector


