

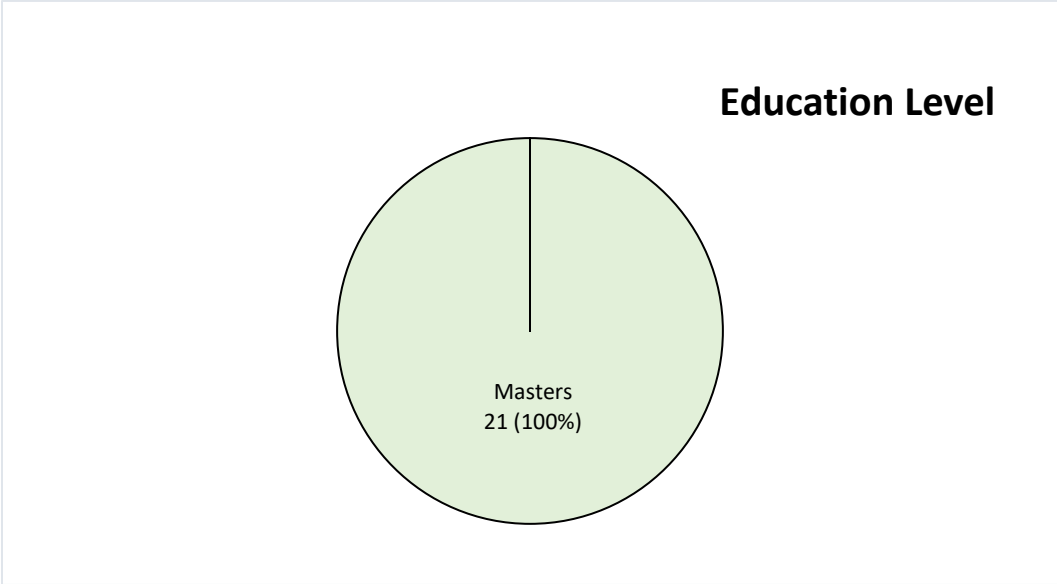
2022 International Health and Sustainable Development Career Outcomes Report

The 2022 International Health and Sustainable Development Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2021, December 2021, and May 2022 in the International Health and Sustainable Development Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

Education Level

Of the 21 student recipients in the International Health and Sustainable Development Department, 21 (100%) graduated with Masters Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

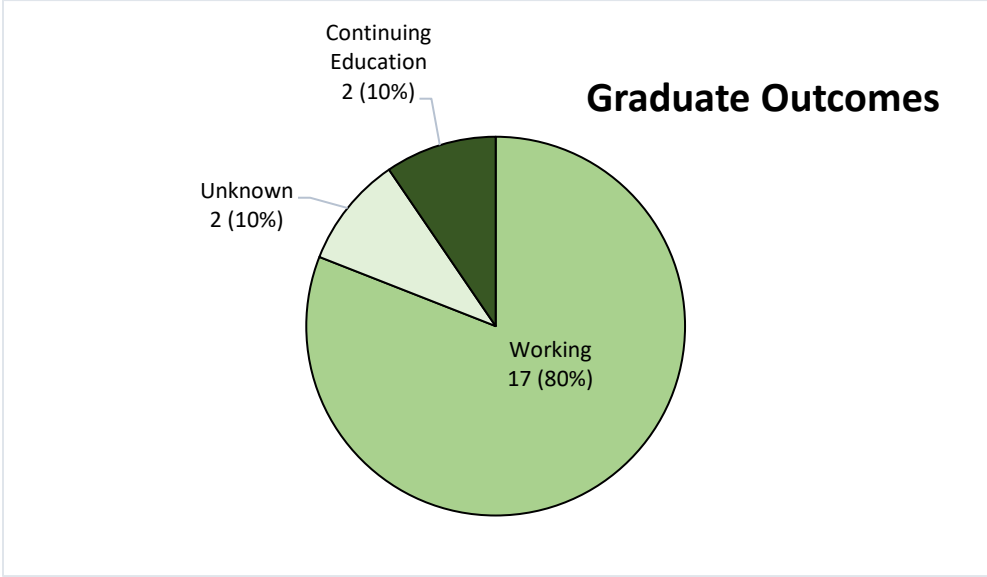
In the 2022 cycle, 21 students received a Master of Public Health Degree (concentrations in International Health and Sustainable Development and International Health).

International Health and Sustainable Development Response Rates and Outcomes

Of the 21 International Health and Sustainable Development student recipients, 19 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey, for a 90% response rate.

Of the 19 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

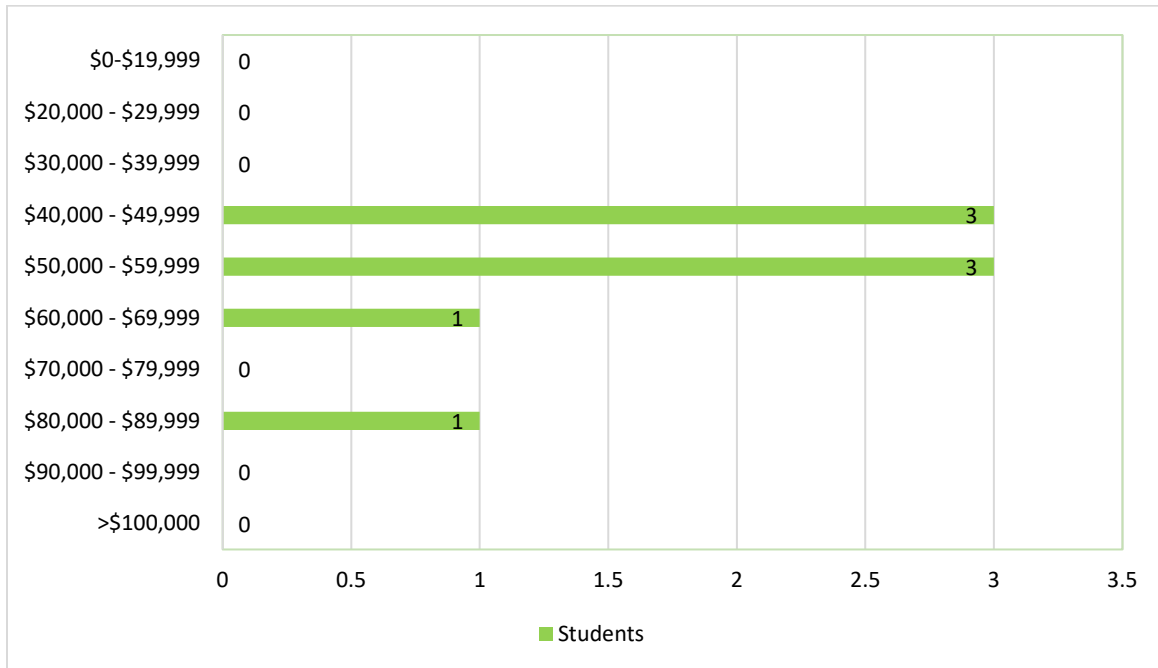
Of the 17 International Health & Sustainable Development students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Sectors included Non-Profit, Healthcare, Government – Local, State & Federal, Management Consulting, and Higher Education.

International Health and Sustainable Development Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by International Health and Sustainable Development graduates securing employment is **\$50,000 - \$59,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 17 students that reported “Working”, 8 students (47%) chose to report their income.
