

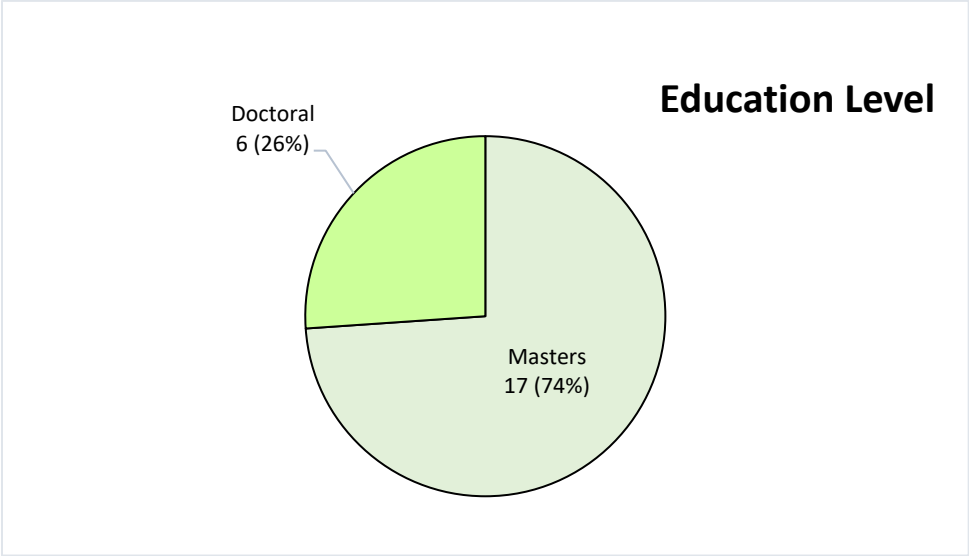
# **2022 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Career Outcomes Report**

The 2022 Tropical Medicine Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2021, December 2021, and May 2022 in the Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

# 2022 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 23 student recipients in the Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Department, 17 students (74%) graduated with Masters Degrees and 6 (26%) students graduated with Doctoral Degrees.



## Breakdown by Degree

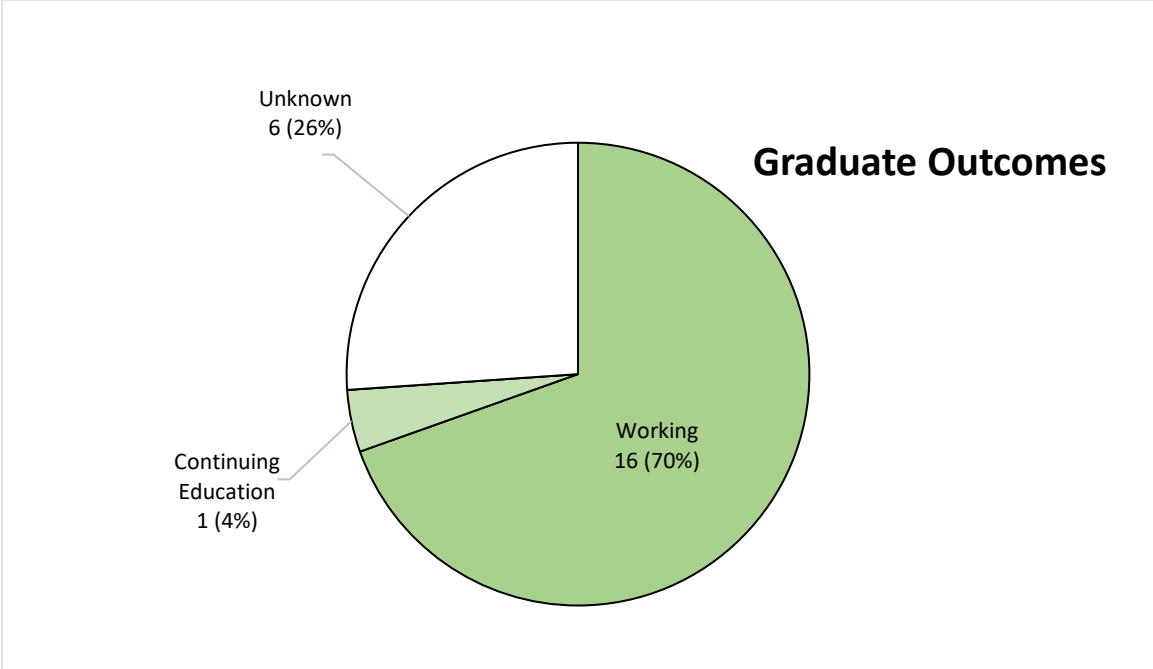
In the 2022 cycle, 1 student received a Master of Science in Tropical Medicine, 1 student received a Master of Science in Public Health in Parasitology, 15 students received a Master of Public Health and Tropical Medicine, and 6 students received a Doctor of Philosophy.

# Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 23 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases student recipients, 17 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey for a 74% response rate.

Of the 17 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

## Employment by Sector

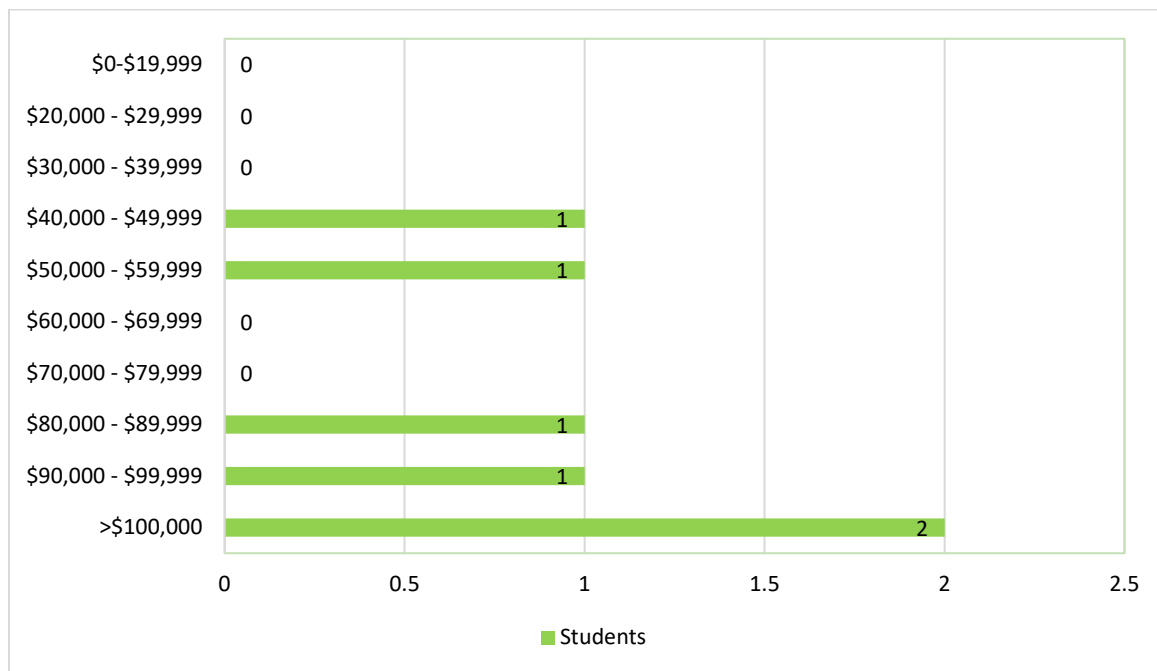
Of the 16 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Sectors included Higher Education, Healthcare, Non-Profit – Other, Government (Local, State, and Federal), Movies, TV, Music, and Scientific and Technical Consulting.

## Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by Tropical Medicine and Infectious Diseases graduates securing employment is **\$85,000 - \$94,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 16 students that reported “Working”, 6 students (38%) chose to report their income.
