

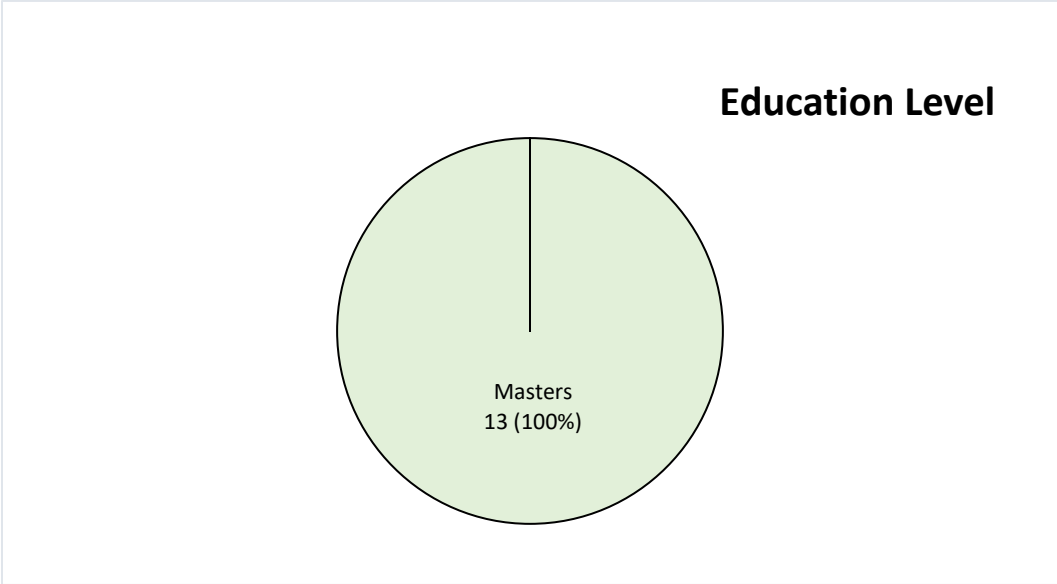
# 2023 International Health and Sustainable Development Career Outcomes Report

The 2023 International Health and Sustainable Development Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2022, December 2022, and May 2023 in the International Health and Sustainable Development Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

# 2023 International Health and Sustainable Development Class Profile

## Education Level

Of the 13 student recipients in the International Health and Sustainable Development Department, 13 (100%) graduated with Masters Degrees.



## Breakdown by Degree

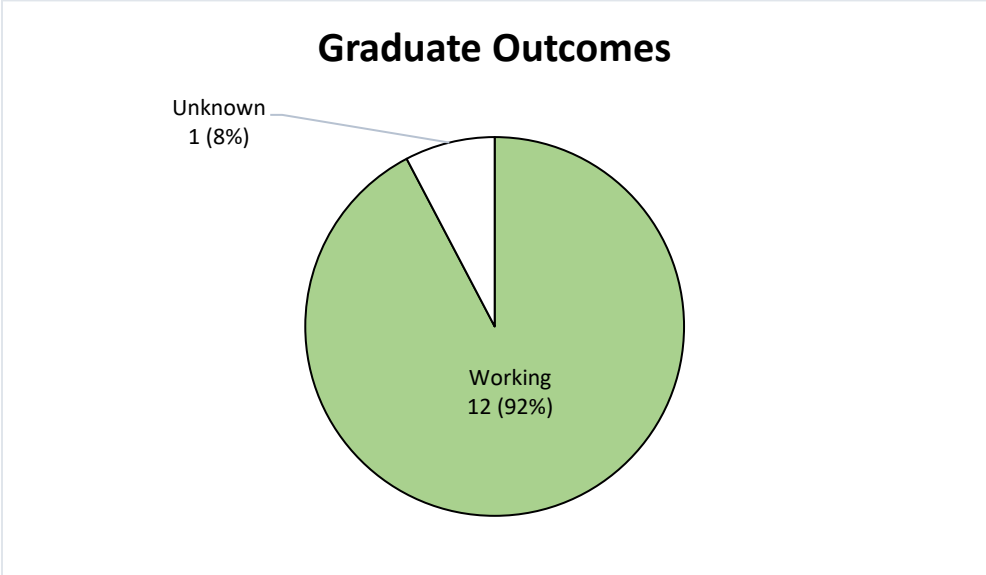
In the 2023 cycle, 13 students received a Master of Public Health in International Health and Sustainable Development.

# International Health and Sustainable Development Response Rates and Outcomes

Of the 13 International Health and Sustainable Development student recipients, 12 responded to the SPHTM First Destination Career Survey, for a 92% response rate.

Of the 12 students who responded, **100% are working within 1 year of graduation.**

## Employment by Sector

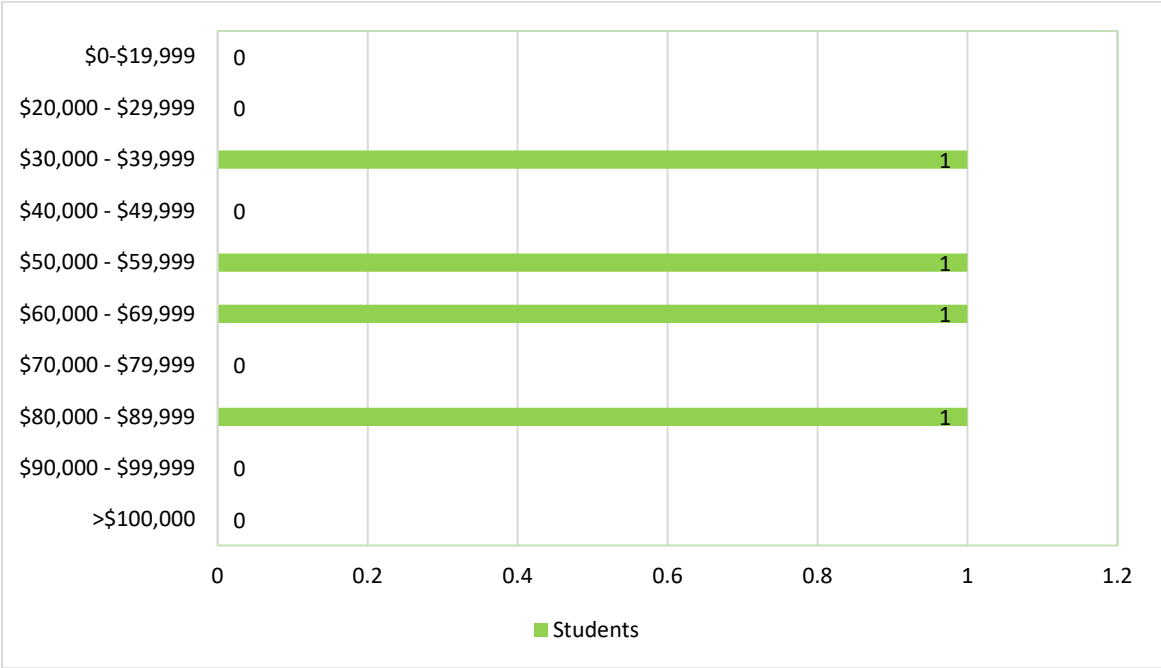

# International Health and Sustainable Development Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by International Health and Sustainable Development graduates securing employment is **\$55,000 - \$64,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 12 students that reported “Working”, 4 students (33%) chose to report their income.
