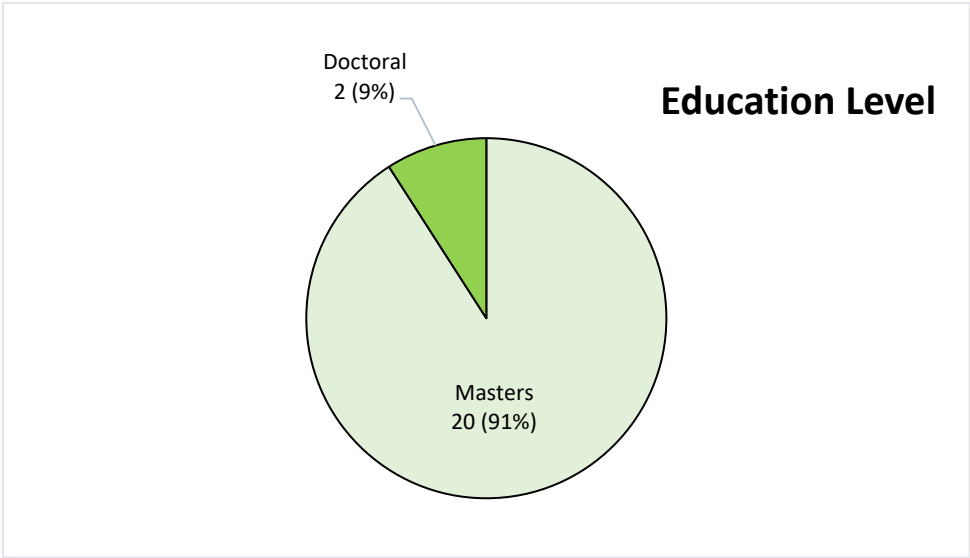
2024 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Career Outcomes Report

The 2024 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Career Outcomes Report includes data from students in the graduating classes of August 2023, December 2023, and May 2024 in the Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Department. Data was collected through the First Destination Survey via the Handshake Career Management Platform. All data is self-reported.

2024 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Class Profile

Education Level

Of the 22 student recipients in the Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Department, 20 students (91%) graduated with Masters Degrees and 2 (9%) students graduated with Doctoral Degrees.



Breakdown by Degree

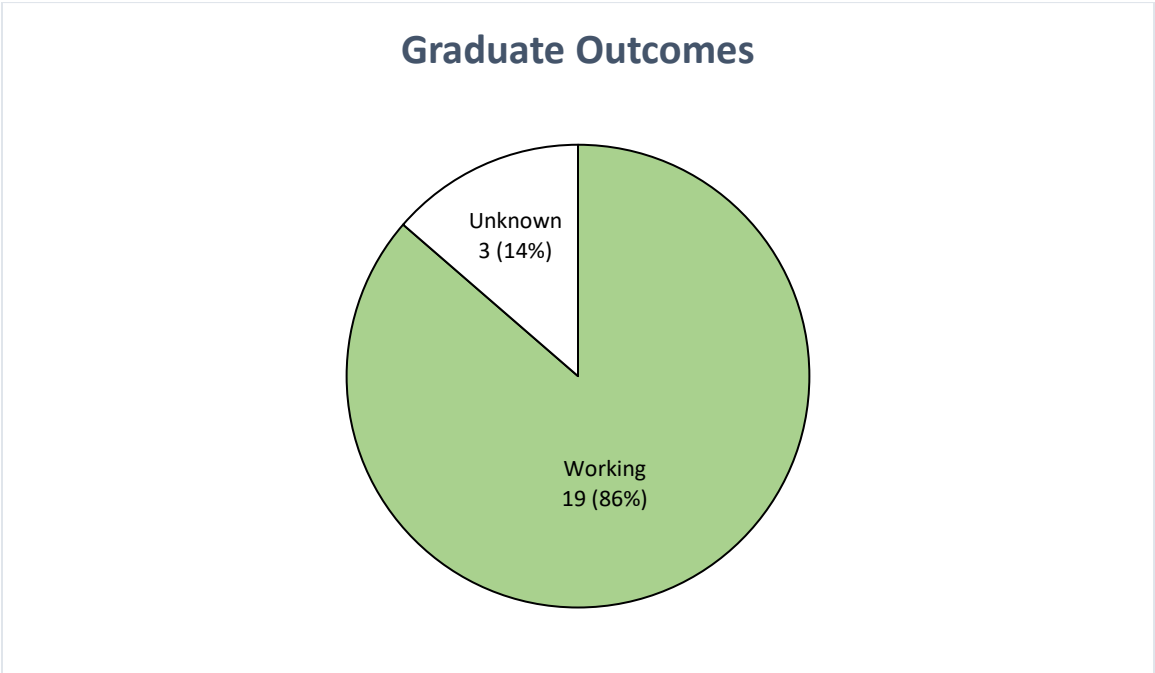
In the 2024 cycle, 4 students received a Master of Science in Tropical Medicine, 16 students received a Master of Public Health and Tropical Medicine, and 2 students received a Doctor of Philosophy in Tropical Medicine.

Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Response Rates and Outcomes

Of 22 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease student recipients, 19 responded to the First Destination Career Survey for a 86% response rate.

Of the 19 students who responded, **100% are working or continuing education within 1 year of graduation.**

Employment by Sector

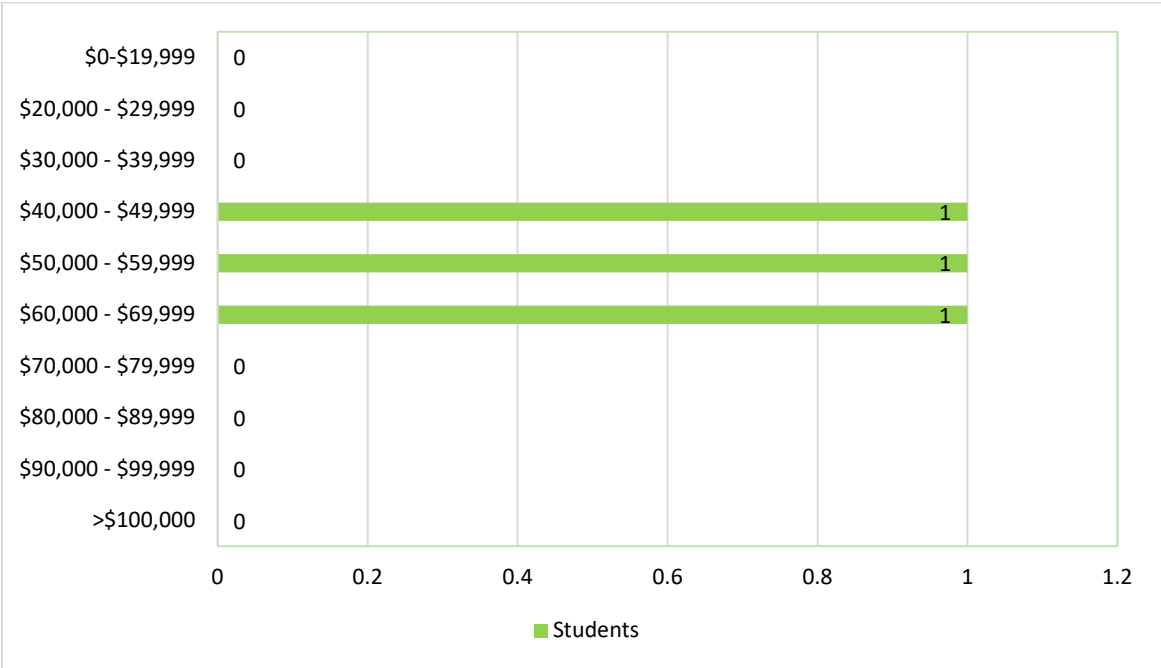
Of the 19 Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease students that reported “Working” within 1 year of graduation, Employment Sectors included Healthcare, Government – Local, State & Federal, Higher Education and Non-Profit-Other.

Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease Salary Ranges

The median starting annual salary range reported by Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease graduates securing employment is **\$50,000 - \$59,999**. It is important to note that the salary data reported by graduates includes those that reported working as fellows or as full-time volunteers (i.e. Peace Corps) which typically offer a stipend and not a salary.

Of the 19 students that reported “Working”, 3 students (16%) chose to report their income.
